که تنها دو نقطه مشخص از جمله حمام و مسجد میرائی در آن وجود دارد که در طرح خیابان قرار نمی‌گیرد و مشکلی برای آنها به وجود نمی‌آید.

### • احداث نخسند خیابان نارضایتی مردم را در پی داشته است

محمدعلی شریعت، عضو شورای اسلامی خمینی‌شهر در دوره‌های چهارم و پنجم در خصوص احداث خیابانی با عرض ۲۰ متر این شهر به خبرنگار ایمناء می‌گوید: سال ۷۶ طرح جامع برای یکی از خیابان‌های خمینی‌شهر با عرض ۲۰ متر تعیین شد، شهرداری با همین روند طی ۲۰ سال گذشته به در راستای طرح جامع حدود ۳۰ درصد از منازل را انتقال مالکیت داده است.

وی با بیان اینکه در طرح تفصیلی سال ۸۲ نیز عرض ۲۰ متر برای احداث این خیابان تصویب شد و شورای عالی شهرسازی و گردشگری و ارگان‌های مربوطه این طرح را تأیید کردند، ادامه می‌دهد: سال ۹۶ در طرح جامع مصوبه شورای عالی شهرسازی تهران، وزیر وقت و کارشناسان میراث فرهنگی دوباره این طرح را تصویب کردند و شهرداری بر اساس همان اقدامات منازل مردم را انتقال مالکیت داد.

عضو شورای اسلامی خمینی‌شهر در دوره‌های چهارم و پنجم تصریح می‌کند: بر اساس طرح مصوب و تعلل در اجرای آن نارضایتی‌هایی برای مردم به وجود آمده است، زیرا مالکیت ملک‌های شهروندان توسط شهرداری گرفته شده است و در تصمیم‌گیری‌های جدید عنوان می‌کنند، عرض خیابان باید ۱۲ متر باشد؛ از این‌رو مردم بدبین و بی‌اعتماد شدند.

وی با اشاره به نارضایتی‌های شهروندان خمینی‌شهر در خصوص وضعیت کنونی، اضافه می‌کند: معاونان میراث فرهنگی، معاون عمرانی استانداری بازدید میدانی از این قسمت داشتند و مشاهده کردند که تنها دو اثر تاریخی، یکی حمام و دیگری مسجد در این قسمت وجود دارد، از این‌رو مقرر شد حفظ این دو اثر تاریخی برعهده شهرداری باشد و خیابانی با عرض ۲۰ متر

احداث شود، زیرا سایر ساختمان‌ها از آهن، آجر و بلوک است و چیزی به عنوان میراث وجود ندارد.

پورشریعت می‌گوید: مدیرکل میراث فرهنگی، صنایع دستی و گردشگری در مصاحبه‌ای اعلام کرد، نظر ما احداث خیابان ۲۰ متری است و شهرداری باید این

مسئله را با توجه به نامیه که مصوبه به ما در سال ۸۵ ارجاع دهد، کمیسیون ماده ۵ ارجاع داده شد، معاونان میراث فرهنگی برخلاف نظر مدیرکل نظر دادند، بنابراین وزیر، مدیرکل میراث فرهنگی و معاون عمرانی استانداری موافق احداث خیابان هستند، اما در زیرمجموعه کار را اقل کردند و اجازه پیشروی نمی‌دهند.

وی ادامه می‌دهد: وزیر میراث فرهنگی نیز گفته است چنین رفتاری با شهروندان و اسیر اضافه می‌کند، معاونان میراث فرهنگی، معاون عمرانی استانداری بازدید میدانی از این قسمت داشتند و مشاهده کردند که تنها دو اثر تاریخی، یکی حمام و دیگری مسجد در این قسمت وجود دارد، از این‌رو مقرر شد حفظ این دو اثر تاریخی برعهده شهرداری باشد و خیابانی با عرض ۲۰ متر

وضعیت دوران پهلوی تکرار شود خوابشان هیچ وقت تعبیر نخواهد شد دیدید با اینکه همه عمله و نکره خودشان را به میدان آوردند از فوتبالیست‌ها، هنر پیشه‌های سینما، خوانندگان، نویسندگان حتی برخی روحانیون و مراجع مصنوعی همه را به میدان آوردند ولی با این حال دیدید که در سوم مهرماه حماسه‌ای همانند ۹ دی تکرار شد مردم بصیرت خودشان نشان می‌دهند مردم علاقمند به اسلام و اهل بیت هستند برمی‌تابند حرکات سیخ‌فی و براندازه ای که توسط عده‌ای فریب خورده انجام می‌شود.

وزیر و مدیرکل میراث فرهنگی، صنایع دستی و گردشگری با احداث خیابان با عرض ۲۰ متر در خمینی‌شهر موافقت کردند، اما معاونان میراث فرهنگی برخلاف نظر مدیرکل نظر می‌دهند و احداث این خیابان که به گفته مدیران شهری ضروری است را دچار مشکل کرده‌اند.

به گزارش خبرنگار ایمناء، هسته اولیه شهرستان خمینی‌شهر اصفهان از سه روستای تاریخی ورنوسفادران، فروشان و خوزان تشکیل و در دوران پهلوی از پیوستن به یکدیگر تبدیل به یک شهر شده است. این شهر هر روز توسعه بیشتری یافت و اکنون شهروندان بسیاری را در خود جای داده است و گاهی ترافیک شهر به بزرگ‌ترین معضل تبدیل می‌شود، در راستای رفع این مشکل مدیریت شهری در نظر دارد تا با احداث خیابان بار ترافیکی شهر را کنترل و عبور و مرور شهروندان را تسهیل کند، در این بین مشکلاتی بر سر راه احداث این خیابان وجود دارد و نهادهایی از جمله میراث در تقابل با شهرداری مولعی را ایجاد کرده است.

با این که مجوز تعریض ۲۰ متر از خیابان بخشدار از سوی معاونت امور مجلس، حقوقی و استان‌ها در وزارت میراث فرهنگی، گردشگری و صنایع دستی صادر شده است، اما همچنان مخالفت‌هایی وجود دارد و اجرای این طرح دچار مشکل شده است.

اکنون اجرای «طرح خیابان بخشداری خمینی‌شهر» که به نظر برخی مسئولان و کارشناسان امر بافت تاریخی و بناهای ارزشمند و تاریخی آن محدود را از بین می‌برد، به نظر مسئولان خمینی‌شهر به کاهش حجم ترافیک شهر کمک خواهد کرد، لذا می‌طلبید سال‌ها متناشه بین وزارت راه و شهرسازی، وزارت میراث فرهنگی و مدیریت شهری و مسئولان محلی به نتیجه‌ای مؤثر برسد تا معضل ترافیک شهر رفع و علاوه بر آن بافت تاریخی این محدوده نیز دچار آسیب نشود.

• **میراث فرهنگی و شهرداری برای احداث خیابان به نتیجه قطعی نرسیدند**

تشریح حادثه تانکر ۳۰ هزار لیتری بنزین در گفت و گو با مدیرکل مدیریت بحران استانداری اصفهان:

### حادثه جاده شاهین شهر مهار شد

اینکه برای حمل و نقل هرگونه مواد خطرناک در کشور باید مجوزهای قانونی از واحدهای ذیربط اخذ شود، عنوان کرد: براساس آیین‌نامه اجرایی ماده ۱۴ مدیریت بحران، حمل و نقل مواد خطرناک ویژگی خاصی دارد و در صورت عدم رعایت ایمنی در هنگام تولید، بارگیری و حمل و نقل سبب آتش‌سوزی و انفجار و آلودگی محیط می‌شود. وی با بیان اینکه روزانه بیش از هزار و ۲۰۰ تانکر از انبار شهید منتظری برای ۱۴ استان سوخت‌گیری می‌کنند، بیان کرد: ناوگان حمل و نقل سوخت باید رعایت الزامات ایمنی را انجام دهند.

شیشه فروش ادامه داد: آیین‌نامه نامه نفتی به شرکت نفت و شرکت‌های حمل و نقل مواد نفتی ابلاغ شده است که

بر اساس این آیین‌نامه باید مسیر حرکت مواد سوختی خطرناک با پلیس هماهنگ شود و بدون هماهنگی تردد نکنند

مدیرکل مدیریت بحران استانداری اصفهان با اشاره به اینکه از اول سال تاکنون این سیزدهمین حادثه واژگونی تانکر سوخت در استان اصفهان بوده است، خاطرنشان کرد: اصفهان چهارراه ارتباطی در مرکز کشور و مسیر حمل و نقل سوخت است، بنابراین رعایت استانداردهای ایمنی توسط شرکت‌هایی که حمل و نقل سوخت را انجام می‌دهند، ضروری است چرا که در صورت بروز حادثه سبب اختلال در تردد و ایجاد ترافیک، آلودگی هوا و خاک می‌شود.



رذیف بودجه و اعتبارات در سفرهای استانی دولت به استان اصفهان و با تخصیص اعتبارات ۲۵ کیلومتر از پروژه فاضلاب فریدون‌شهر اجرا شد و پروژه ۳۰ درصد پیشرفت داشت.

مدیر آبیای شهرستان فریدون‌شهر خاطرنشان می‌کند: طی ۱۰ سال گذشته با توجه به سرعت بالای پروژه، ۳۰۰۰ انشعاب پیش‌فروش و همین امر مزید بر علت شده که انتقادات مردمی نسبت به مسکوت ماندن اجرای طرح فاضلاب را در پی داشته است.

بیلولی با بیان اینکه درحال‌حاضر برای اجرای مابقی پروژه ۴۰۰ میلیارد تومان اعتبار برآورد شده است، را خواهیم داشت تا این طرح به سرانجام برسد و رضایت‌مندی شهروندان حاصل و انتظار چندین ساله آنان محقق شود.

### • پیگیر جذب اعتبارات برای اجرای پروژه هستیم

محمدرضا بیلولی، مدیر آبیای شهرستان فریدون‌شهر در این خصوص می‌گوید: سال ۱۳۷۴ در شهرستان فریدون‌شهر پروژه ۸۵ کیلومتری توزیع شبکه فاضلاب شهری در حالی آغاز شد که رذیف بودجه و اعتبارات آن در پیگیریهایی که از طریق کمیسیون ماده ۲۳ انجام شده است.

فرمانده انتظامی شهرستان شهرضا:

### افزایش ۷۰ درصدی کشفیات کالای قاچاق در شهرضا

فرمانده انتظامی شهرستان شهرضا گفت: در بخش قاچاق کالا و حمایت از اقتصاد داخلی با کشف بیش از ۶۵ میلیارد تومان انواع کالای قاچاق در ایست و بازرسی شهید امامی شهرضا قرقانی فرمانده انتظامی شهرستان شهرضا در گفت‌وگو با خبرنگار فارس در شهرستان شهرضا اظهار داشت: فرماندهی انتظامی جمهوری اسلامی ایران به عنوان یکی از ارکان امنیت‌ساز کشور، مجاهدت‌ها و تلاش‌های افتخار‌آمیزی را برای تولید امنیت و آگاهی‌بخشی به جامعه در قبال حاکمیت قانون و صیانت از ارزش‌های اجتماعی رقم زده است.

وی با بیان اینکه امروز فرماندهی انتظامی با وجود کارکنانی خدمت و زحمتمکش در راه سیره شهیدان و تأمین نظم و امنیت مردم از هیچ کوششی دریغ نکرده است، افزود: خدمت‌رسانی شبانه‌روزی، اقتدار توأم با رأفت و مهربانی، تلاش در جهت برقراری آسایش و امنیت بر کسی پوشیده نیست و مردم ایران اسلامی شاهد فآکاری سبزه‌پوشان خوم هستند.

قرقانی بیان کرد: اسهال هفته نیروی انتظامی با شعار «پلیس خادم مردم و مردم حامی پلیس» در حالی آغاز می‌کنیم که کارکنان فراجا روزه‌های بسیار پر فراز و نشیمی را در کمال خویشتنداری و با روحیه‌ای خستگی‌ناپذیر سپری کردند.

فرمانده انتظامی شهرستان شهرضا با بیان اینکه امروز ایران اسلامی به برکت خود شهپدا از مرز تا مرکز از امنیت مثال‌زدنی برخوردار است و همگان به اهمیت کار پلیس در جامعه پی برده‌اند، تصریح کرد: وقتی امنیت نباشد تحصیل، فعالیت اصناف و کارهای روزمره انجام نمی‌شود.

### • کاهش ۱۳ درصدی سرقت در ۶ ماهه نخست سال در شهرضا

وی در بخش دیگری از صحبت‌های خود با بیان اینکه یکی از شاخصه‌های مهم امنیت کنترل سرقت‌ها است، عنوان کرد: در شش ماهه نخست سال سرقت در شهرضا ۱۳ درصد سرقت کاهش داشته است و ۲۶ درصد توان کشف انتظامی شهرضا ارتقا پیدا کرده و سارقان ۱۰ درصد نسبت به سال گذشته

بیشتر دستگیر شدند. قرقانی با اشاره به اینکه بیش از ۴۰۰ نفر سارق در ۶ ماهه اسهال در شهرضا دستگیر و روانه زندان شدند، ادامه داد: سرقت‌های مسلحانه، به عنف، زورگیری و راهزنی در شهرستان شهرضا تحت کنترل پلیس است.

فرمانده انتظامی شهرستان شهرضا با بیان اینکه در بحث سوخت قاچاق بیش از ۱۲۲ هزار لیتر انواع سوخت قاچاق در شهرضا کشف و ضبط شده است، اضافه کرد: کشف سلاح جنگی و شکاری ۱۷ درصد، مشروبات داخلی و خارجی به ترتیب ۱۱۳ و ۷ هزار و ۷۶۳ درصد، دستگیری معتادان ۹ درصد و دستگیری خردفروشان و قاچاقچیان مواد مخدر ۱۷ درصد افزایش داشته‌ایم.

وی با اشاره به رشد ۴۰ درصدی دستگیری اتباع بیگانه در این شهرستان گفت: در بخش قاچاق کالا و حمایت از اقتصاد داخلی با کشف بیش از ۶۵ میلیارد تومان انواع قاچاق در ایست و بازرسی شهید امامی شهرضا ۷۰ درصد رشد را شاهد بوده‌ایم.

قرقانی با بیان اینکه کل دستگیری‌های شهرستان شهرضا نسبت به سال گذشته ۳۷ درصد افزایش و درگیری‌ها ۵ درصد نسبت به سال گذشته کاهش داشته است، گفت: تصادفات برون و درون شهری ۱۵ درصد کاهش داشته است.

### • صدور ۲ هزار جلد گذرنامه در ایام اربعین در شهرضا

فرمانده انتظامی شهرستان شهرضا با اشاره به خدمات پلیس راهور در ایام عاشورا و تاسوعا، اربعین و ایام نوروز در راستای کنترل ترافیک، افزود: بیش از ۱۴۰ طرح درخصوص برخورد با تخلفات حادثه‌ساز در شهرضا اجرا شده است.

## Iran, Venezuela ink coop. agreement for producing Iranian cars in Venezuela

Iran's SAIPA Car Manufacturing Company and Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela signed a cooperation agreement with the aim of producing Iranian cars in this country, the Public Relations Department of SAIPA Automotive Group reported.

The cooperation agreement was inked between CEO of SAIPA Automotive Group Mohammad Ali Teimouri and Venezuelan Minister of Transportation Ramón Velásquez at the venue of SAIPA Company in Tehran in order to produce Iranian cars in this country as joint venture (JV).

The Chief Executive of SAIPA Automotive Group Teimouri said that in the first phase of cooperation, parts of SAIPA's cars are sent to Venezuela within the framework of Completely Built Up (CBU) in the first phase and then, VENIRATO Company's production line will be activated in cooperation and collaboration between the two parties and cars will be assembled in the form of Semi-Knocked Down (SKD) basis.

It is hoped that SAIPA Company, in addition to providing Venezuelan people with the high-quality Iranian cars, would be able to generate and boom employment opportunities in this country, Teimouri emphasized. He thanked the Venezuelan government for its serious determination to jointly cooperate for producing Iranian cars in this South American country.

Venezuelan Transport Minister, for his part, pointed to the cooperation of his country with Iran's SAIPA Company in previous years and said that this amicable cooperation between the two sides will be strengthened in line with producing most modern and up-to-date cars for the Venezuelan people.

Today, Venezuela is seeking to renew its cooperation with Iran's SAIPA Company, Ramón Velásquez said, adding that this cooperation agreement is the outset of renewal of cooperation of Venezuelan government with Iran's SAIPA Automotive Group Company.

After the visit of President of Venezuela Nicolás Maduro to the Islamic Republic of Iran over the past months, it was agreed that cooperation between the two countries of Iran and Venezuela would continue stronger than before, so that Venezuela can be considered as user of SAIPA's vehicles. He then pointed to organizing Iranian Auto Exhibition in Venezuela and added that Venezuelan visitors highly welcomed Iranian-made cars.

After the exhibition, a public opinion was conducted in this country and it was cleared that 62 Venezuelan people are applicant for buying Iranian cars and this shows the vehement interest of Venezuelan people to Iranian products and SAIPA Automotive Group's cars, the minister added. Elsewhere in his remarks, Venezuelan Transport Minister pointed to the cooperation of his country with SAIPA Automotive Group and added that SAIPA enjoys high capability to have its special customers in this country. "We are trying to introduce SAIPA Automotive Group as a regional hub for exporting products of SAIPA Automotive Group," he added.

Considering the high quality of its products, SAIPA Automotive Group can play a leading role in the countries of the Latin American region in order to export its products to Caribbean and Latin American region. Venezuela can play the role of a linking bridge for export of SAIPA Company to other countries in the Latin American region, the Venezuelan minister added.

According to the cooperation agreement made, SAIPA Company will send its products to Venezuela in the form of Completely Built Up (CBU) at the first step, he said, adding that the company will send 2,000 of its products to this country by the end of the current Iranian calendar year in 1401 (to end March 20, 2023).



## Iran won't leave negotiating table: Raisi



Iranian President Ayatollah Seyed Ebrahim Raisi has said that Iran remains committed to proceeding with negotiations in Vienna.

In a speech delivered Saturday in the all-female University of Al-Zahra on the occasion of the start of the new academic year, President Raisi touched on the talks in Vienna over reviving the 2015 nuclear deal, officially known as the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA), among other issues.

Ayatollah Raisi explained the logic of the government in the negotiations to lift the sanctions and the enemy's attempt to impose its conditions on Iran and said, "We announced from the beginning that we would not leave the negotiation table, but we would stick to honorable negotiations, and today the logic of the Islamic Republic of Iran is accepted in

the world." Pointing out that today almost 60% of the country's students are female students, President Raisi described the combined spirit of research with science and tolerance of female students to be effective in this field and added, "In the years after the victory of the Islamic Revolution, women have shined in many academic fields of the country and have even been able to show off their abilities in the global fields."

He noted, "When an educated Iranian woman makes an important scientific achievement at the world level and is placed on a platform, the flag of the Islamic Republic is raised and the national anthem of Iran is played; this creates strength for the country".

Stating that science and knowledge are important components of power and ability,

Ayatollah Raisi said, "Today, the country has achieved high levels of power and ability with the efforts of professors and students. While in the past we needed to import barbed wire and we were denied the same, today we have achieved amazing progress in various scientific and industrial fields despite the most extensive sanctions; and with the God's help, this path will continue."

In another part of his speech, President Raisi congratulated the new students and stated, "Devote all your efforts to research, and the government will also use all its efforts to provide the necessary facilities for you."

Ayatollah Raisi also said resolving employment concerns of male and female students as one of the tasks of his government. He added, "The government considers university as

its think tank and expects universities and scientific centers to come to the aid of the government with new ideas and initiatives."

### Ethnic diversity a sign of strength

Earlier on Friday, President Raisi attended a ceremony for commemorating the National Day of Nomads and Villages. At the ceremony, Raisi described ethnic diversity in Iran as the strength of the Islamic Republic in the direction of developing resistance economy.

He described creating 300,000 jobs in villages and utilizing 12,000 rural economic and infrastructure projects as great and valuable measures taken for developing rural economy.

He added, "Although water, electricity, schools and health clinics are provided in villages today, we still see the migration of villagers because they do not

see the rural economy as profitable."

Raisi said the slogan of "knowledge-based producing village" is the solution to this problem and said, "Combining the valuable lifestyle of nomads and villagers with modern science and knowledge forms a complete production chain that promotes knowledge-based production."

Referring to the formation of the "Supreme Council of Construction Jihad" in his administration to support the activities of voluntary groups and energizing rural economy, the president said, "The capacities that exist in village are not small, and these capacities can be developed with integrated policies, looking at the priorities."

President Raisi also called the establishment of a system for mapping the situation of the country's villages a valuable measure to inform the officials about the situation of rural society, saying, "The existence of a mechanism to monitor the affairs of village is a necessity so that the officials can monitor the problems of village in real time."

Ayatollah Raisi also pointed out the importance of exploiting mines in the development of villages and stated, "Activation of closed and semi-closed mines is on the agenda of the government, and in this context, it has been emphasized that a part of the mining revenues should be allocated for the development of villages in the same region."

Elsewhere in his remarks, the president said in most of his meetings with foreign leaders he has clearly "declared that the Islamic Republic of Iran has made significant progress despite the severe sanctions."

## Iran's 4-month paper production up 4.3% yr/yr

Iran produced 390,700 tons of paper in the first four months of the current Iranian calendar year (March 21-July 22), according to the data released by Industry, Mining, and Trade Ministry. The min-

istry's data show that the country's paper output has increased 4.3 percent in the four-month period of this year from that of the previous year, IRIB reported. The head of the Iranian Syndicate of Paper

and Cardboard Manufacturers says that considering the country's potentials and capacities Iran could easily become a hub for the supply of mentioned products in the region. "Due to the general conditions

and available facilities, Iran has the potential to become a regional production hub in many industries including the paper and cardboard sector," Abolfazl Roghani Golpayegani told IRNA in June 2021.

## Iran's Bagheri Kani resumes consultations in Serbia

Iran's Deputy Foreign Minister for Political Affairs Ali Bagheri Kani who is on a European tour, arrived in Serbia early on Friday. He then had a fairly jam-packed schedule, having six meetings in a day.

On Friday afternoon, Bagheri Kani met with Serbia's State Secretary in the Ministry of Trade, Tourism and Telecommunications Stevan Nikcevic. During the meeting, the Iranian diplomat referred to the shared experience of the two countries in facing cruel and unilateral sanctions, noting that sanctions are external and bureaucratic problems and an internal obstacle in the way of developing the two countries' economic cooperation. Bagheri Kani further stressed the need to remove those hindrances and exchange experiences through appropriate approaches.

He hoped that Iran's foreign minister would travel to Serbia and the Serbian president would travel to Iran in the near future.

According to the top diplomat, those trips could demonstrate the leaders of the two countries' determination to develop relations in all fields.

For his part, Nikcevic enumerated the available capacities for enhancement of economic relations and expressed hope that the 16th Joint Economic Commission would be held immediately after the Serbia's new administration is formed.

He added that the level of economic



and trade relations did not match political ties.

During the meeting, both sides stressed the importance of starting expert-level talks to hammer out a free trade agreement and using creative mechanisms to enhance economic exchanges and cooperation between the two countries.

Later, as part of his busy schedule in Belgrade, Bagheri Kani held an interactive session with representatives of some Serbian media outlets.

During the meeting, the Iranian diplomat said based on the agreements reached between the two sides, the legal foundations of Iran-Serbia ties will see a boost with the signing of important documents to cooperate in political, economic and cultural areas

in the near future.

The Iranian deputy foreign minister pointed to the outcome of his negotiations with Serbian officials, saying, "The Islamic Republic of Iran and Serbia are seeking to enhance mutual cooperation in different sectors, given their long-running history of relations and common interests."

Bagheri announced plans for the signing of significant cooperation documents in different fields including economy, trade, fight against organized crimes, employment, sports-social welfare, hygiene, and higher education in the near future.

These documents are scheduled to be signed and exchanged between the two sides as part of the planned agenda of Iran's foreign minister's visit to

Belgrade and the Serbian president's trip to Tehran, he added.

During the visit, the deputy foreign minister explained Iran's positions on the nuclear talks, the crisis in Ukraine, and issues related to the energy crisis. Bagheri Kani holds high-level economic talks in Belgrade

Later, as part of his talks with Serbian officials, Bagheri Kani sat down with State Secretary of Serbia's Ministry of Finance Gojko Stanivukovic.

The Iranian deputy foreign minister pointed to the two countries' experience with the United States' cruel sanctions. He described bureaucratic issues as one of the main obstacles to the expansion of economic cooperation between the two sides and stressed the necessity of removing those obstacles.

For his part, the Serbian official emphasized his country's political will for economic cooperation with Iran, noting that the current level of trade exchanges between the two sides is not enough.

The deputy finance minister expressed Serbia's readiness for consultations with the Iranian side and putting forward initiatives toward making use of the two countries' economic capacities.

The two sides also emphasized the formation of a joint working group to study ways of removing the obstacles facing economic cooperation, especially those related to sanctions.

## Iran, UAE target reaching \$30b annual trade in 2 years: TPO official

Targeting \$30 billion trade between Iran and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) for the next two years is on the agenda of the trade organizations of the two countries, according to an official with Iran's Trade Promotion Organization (TPO). Farzad Pilten, the director-general of TPO's Office of West Asian Countries, said the UAE is considered as one of the important countries in Iran's foreign trade. Pointing out that the balance of trade volume between the two countries has always been in favor of the UAE, Pilten added: "According to the plans, balancing, maintaining and improving the level of trade relations between the two countries is on the agenda of trade organizations."

"Considering the position and capacities and facilities that the UAE has for the development of bilateral and multilateral cooperation at the regional and international level, by removing trade barriers and increasing export standards and insurances, we can reach \$30 billion trade with the UAE", the TPO official added.

In a report, released in mid-September, the Research Center of Iran Chamber of Commerce, Industries, Mines and Agriculture (ICCI-MA) stated that the United Arab Emirates' new strategies for inking free trade agreements with India and Turkey is going to further enhance the Islamic Republic's mediatory role in the region. As one of Iran's top trade partners in the region, UAE has always been a hot market for Iranian businessmen and traders and the expansion of this country's economic relations with Iran's neighbors could positively impact Iranian trade with them as well.

Based on the mentioned report, the UAE has recently focused on forming free trade agreements with a range of countries including India, Britain, Turkey, South Korea, Ethiopia, Indonesia, and Kenya.

Also, this country is a member of a large set of trade-related international organizations and treaties the most important of which are the World Trade Organization, the Persian Gulf Cooperation Council, the GCC-EFTA Free Trade Agreement, and the Pan-Arab Free Trade Area.

Among the above-mentioned countries, India and Turkey are of significance for Iran, because as for Turkey, the trade agreement with the UAE has the potential to become an important economic, political, and transit advantage for Iran.

As for India, although the agreement could undermine the position of Chabahar port as a regional trade hub for the country, but considering the geopolitical situation of the mentioned port, it will still remain a center of regional trade for India with regard to Russia and Central Asia.

**Powerlifter Abaeian banned for two years**

Iranian powerlifter Alireza Abaeian has been banned for two years for anti-doping rule violation. He has been banned for using prohibited substance Fentanyl. Abaeian is ineligible from Sept. 4,

2022 to Sept. 2, 2024. Fentanyl can be absorbed into the body via inhalation, oral exposure or ingestion, or skin contact. Fentanyl can be administered intravenously (IV), intramuscularly (IM), or as a skin patch.

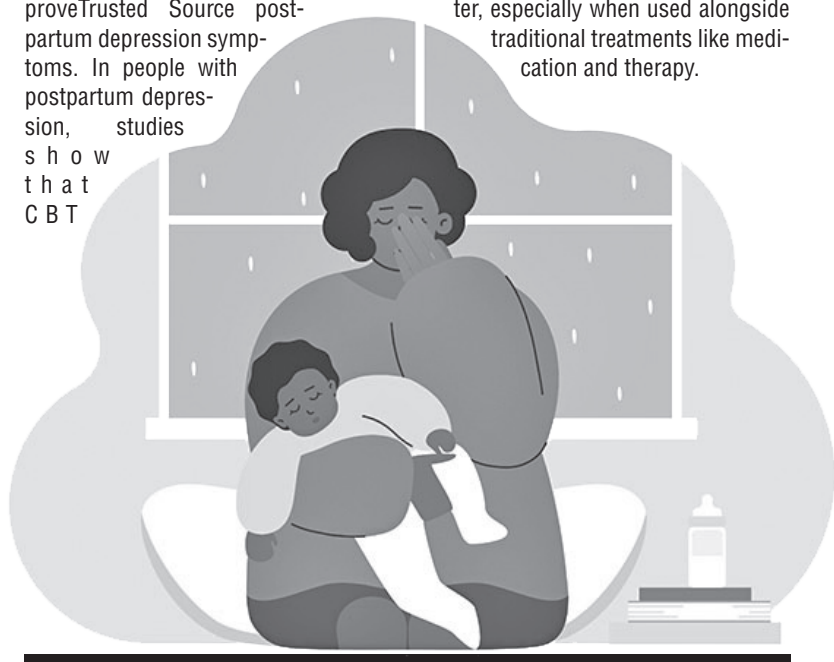

**TEDPIX gains 2,800 points on Saturday**

TEDPIX, the main index of Tehran Stock Exchange (TSE), rose 2,868 points to 1.316 million on Saturday (first day of Iranian calendar week). As reported, over 4.303 billion securities worth 32.429 trillion rials (about \$111.8 million) were traded at the TSE. The first market's index rose 4,427 points, and the second market's index gained 1,236 points. TSE is one of the four Iranian stock exchanges, the other three ones are Iran Mercantile Exchange (IME), Iran Energy Exchange (IRENEX), and Iran's over-the-counter (OTC) market, known as Iran Fara Bourse (IFB). An Iranian capital market analyst believes that various internal and external factors have contributed to the current downward trend in the stock market and no single person or entity is at fault for the situation. "The current situation in the capital market (the decline in the market index) cannot be attributed to a specific person, organization or institution; Rather, various factors have come together and created the basis for such a trend in the market," Shahin Cheraghi told IRNA on Wednesday (September 28).

**Transport fleet renovation plans discussed at ICCIMA meeting**

The members of the transport and energy committees of Iran Chamber of Commerce, Industries, Mines and Agriculture (ICCIMA) held a joint meeting on Saturday in which the government's transport fleet renovation programs were discussed. As reported by the ICCIMA portal, the attendees of the meeting emphasized that the government must put a certain body in charge of the implementation of the mentioned programs in order to be able to monitor their progress. Speaking in this meeting, Ali Hossein, the head of ICCIMA Transport and Logistics Committee, said: "One of the problems in the way of implementation of fleet renovation programs is the failure of the government and the Oil Ministry in fulfilling their obligations." According to the official, the government has not paid part of its dues to the private contractors that have contributed to the mentioned programs. "Oil Ministry owes one of the contractors 100 million dollars, and if the obligation is not fulfilled, having a worn-out fleet is going to be inevitable," he said. "One of our priorities is the modernization of the road transportation fleet, which we hope will be achieved soon," the official stressed. The members of the mentioned committees also underlined the programs' lack of attractiveness for the owners of worn-out vehicles, saying that the government must provide the owners of such cars with special incentives to encourage their participation. "If a plan is to be implemented successfully, it should be beneficial for the owner of the worn-out car. But none of the plans proposed by the government so far have been attractive to the beneficiaries. The design should be attractive to both buyers and car manufacturers," the officials said in a statement.

**Riots' long-term consequences for Iranian economy**



Iran has witnessed incidents of street violence over the past few days following the death of a 22-year-old woman, Mahsa Amini, in hospital after she was taken by morality police for violating social dress codes. Despite clarification on the circumstances surrounding Amini's death, with the incitement of anti-Iran media, rioters appeared in the streets of some cities and damaged public property. The violent protests led to attacks on security officers and acts of vandalism against public property as well as ambulances and police vehicles. Economy experts believe that such acts of vandalism, in addition to their immediate consequences, are going to have significant negative impacts on the Iranian economy in the long term. According to University Professor and Economy Expert Gholamreza Khankeshi-Pour, the impact of the riots can be considered from two aspects, one is the financial impacts summed as a series of damages to public property, public funds, all kinds of ambulances, fire brigade, police, municipal machinery, buildings commercial, office buildings, banks, hospitals, mosques and the other is the loss of lives, mental and psychological distress and disruption of people's comfort and peace. Mentioning the banning of some social media platforms like Instagram in the wake of the riots, Khankeshi-Pour said the limitations on access to such

platforms will impose a great load on online businesses that are active on these apps. Emphasizing the need to pay attention to the destructive effect of unrest on the country's macroeconomics, he said: "The most important damage from unrest is on the macroeconomics, because the security of investment, especially foreign investment, which has grown significantly in recent years, can be severely affected by the unrest." Head of the Iran Chamber of Guilds Ghasem Nodeh-Farahani also believes that various businesses were damaged due to the recent unrest and this issue challenges the country's economy. "Guilds in different parts of the country suffered from this situation because some of the businesses started their activities in the evening hours and continued until midnight and the riots forced them to close up their shops," Nodeh-Farahani said. Emphasizing that security and peace are the prerequisites for economic growth, the official stated: "Due to the riots, not only the businesses that are directly related to the street conditions will be affected but all the country's economic cycle will also be impacted." "In the economic cycle, all sectors are dependent on each other, and creating a disruption in one of the sectors will involve other sectors as well because guilds should operate as a group and not individually," he explained.

Regarding the damages to public properties, Abdolmotahar Mohammadkhani, the spokesman of Tehran Municipality, told Tasnim news agency that during the recent riots, 25 light and heavy vehicles and one Toyota vehicle with full equipment belonging to the Tehran fire department and safety services of Tehran Municipality were destroyed. The official estimated the damages imposed on the Tehran public properties at about 165 billion rials (over \$550,000). The government has said that the rioters must compensate for the damages they caused to public properties. Iran's government spokesman Ali Bahadori-Jahromi said in late September that the rioters and those who provoked them in the recent unrest must compensate for the harm they caused to the Iranian nation. "In recent days, we have seen organized acts of sabotaging the grounds for which were prepared by the opposition media," Bahadori-Jahromi said on the sidelines of the cabinet session. Although the short-term damages caused by the unrest might be compensated relatively fast, the long-term consequences on the economy are in fact more significant. Hopefully, the government will come up with some ideas to handle the situation and alleviate the limitations on access to some platforms on which many businesses are currently active.

**Tehran hosting summit on transit co-op with Central Asia**



The first summit on transit cooperation between Iran and five central Asian countries including Turkmenistan, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, and Kyrgyzstan, kicked off in Tehran on Saturday, IRIB reported. According to Iranian Deputy Foreign Minister for Economic Diplomacy Mehdi Safari, during the two-day event, challenges and opportunities of expanding transit collaboration between Iran and the mentioned Central Asian nations will be explored. "This gathering will lead to the adoption of a more coordinated policy among the present countries, and hopefully result in providing solutions for the obstacles regarding transit cooperation," Safari said at the opening ceremony of the summit. Iran eyes 20 million tons of annual transit. The official stated that Iran is seeking to reach common policies with Central Asian countries in order to achieve an annual 20-million-ton transit goal. "Iran will provide transit routes to its landlocked neighbors to achieve this goal," Safari said. Emphasizing the need for the development of international transit corridors passing through Iran, he added: "We must create a management system for such corridors in order to use for improving rail, sea, and air routes." "We will soon hold an international

conference in this field," he said. Also speaking at the summit, Deputy Transport Minister Shahriyar Afandizadeh said: "Due to the formation of the current constructive and interactive atmosphere in the field of international transportation and transit among the present members, and considering Iran's bilateral and multilateral agreements with other countries, a new chapter will be opened in the country's transportation and transit collaborations." "We hope this summit will lead to reaching smart and purposeful decisions for the cooperation among all members in such a way that favorable conditions are provided for the development of infrastructure and transportation facilities," he said. Afandizadeh pointed out that in the current meeting, in addition to providing a suitable space for the exchange of views as well as bilateral meetings between the ministers and other senior transport officials of the respective countries, a final cooperation document is expected to be approved by the attendees. "The draft of this document was sent to the respected members prior to the summit," he said. According to the official, the improvement of border traffic, digital development in transit processes, facilitation of embassy affairs and visa issuance for drivers, as well as continuous improvement of tariffs and transit charges are among the major goals of the summit.
