کارت های منزلت شهروندی چه سرنوشتی پیدا کردند؟

Rights Group Reports over 100 Israeli Violations in Palestine

The Palestinian Center for Human Rights (PCHR) documented over 100 violations of international human rights law inflicted by Israeli occupation forces and settlers in just one week in the occupied Palestinian territories.

According to a PCHR report published yesterday, a total of 106 Israeli human rights abuses were comprehensively recorded; however, the restrictions imposed under the state of emergency have hindered the NGO's ability to cover all incidents in the occupied territories, the Middle East Monitor reported.

"This week, which marked the Muslim holiday, Eid al-Fitr, which celebrates the end of the holy month of Ramadan, was no different, as IOF attacks continued; additionally, settlers shot and wounded Palestinian farmers, set lands ablaze and attacked houses," the rights NGO stated.

As noted by PCHR, Israeli forces unlawfully killed five Palestinian civilians, including a child who posing no imminent threat to life, using live ammunition during Israeli military raids into Ramallah and Tubas.

Moreover, Israel continued to expand illegal settlements and related infrastructure in the occupied West Bank, including the dismantling of a caravan and demolition of a house still-under-construction in the central Jordan Valley, because it did not have the necessary permissions from the Israeli occupation authorities.

Such permits are almost impossible for Palestinians to obtain. It said three Palestinians were forced to demolish their homes themselves.

E3 regrets US decision to end waivers covering JCPOA nuclear projects in Iran

In a joint statement on Saturday, spokespersons of the High Representative of the European Union and the Foreign Ministries of France, Germany and the United Kingdom deeply regretted the US decision to end the three waivers covering key JCPOA nuclear projects in Iran, including the Arak Modernisation Project.

"These projects, endorsed by UN Security Council resolution 2231, serve the non-proliferation interests of all and provide the international community with assurances of the exclusively

peaceful and safe nature of Iranian nuclear activities," the statements said.

"We are consulting with our partners to assess the consequences of this decision by the United States," it added. Terming the JCPOA as a key achievement of the global architecture, the statement said, "That is why we have worked continuously with the aim of ensuring the full and effective implementation of commitments under the JCPOA, in particular the return of Iran to full compliance with its nuclear commitments without delay."

US Secretary of State in a message earlier said, "I am ending the sanctions waiver for JCPOA-related projects in Iran, effective in 60 days. Iran's continued nuclear escalation makes clear this cooperation must end."

Chinese Foreign Ministry Spokesperson Zhao Lijian said on Friday that China firmly opposes US recent decision to end sanctions waiver against Iran, adding that it demonstrates its consistent pattern of unilateral and hegemonic practice.

"The US has chosen to stick to its maximum pressure campaign on Iran," Lijian said in his regular press conference, adding, "The US has not only unilaterally withdrawn from the JCPOA in violation of the UNSCR but also ratcheted up efforts to thwart other parties' implementation of the deal."



German FM makes unfounded claims about Iranian govt.'s pressure on media regarding COVID19-

Some European governments have gone beyond planting opportunistic elements to put pressure on the Iranian media and government regarding the freedom of the Iranian press amid the pandemic, and have now reached a point where they make baseless claims without any evidence.



Political pressures hiding behind 'freedom of the press' façade

The baseless pressures of some European

governments regarding the freedom of the Iranian press inside and outside the country have gone beyond planting opportunistic elements to put pressure on the Iranian media and government and have now reached making baseless claims without any evidence. In his recent speech at Germany's parliament, the German Foreign Minister Heiko Maas while noting the various dire consequences of the coronavirus pandemic, named what he called "repressive measures taken against journalists in Iran, Russia, Venezuela, Turkey, and China" as examples of such consequences.

Of course, Heiko Maas made the claim against these countries without providing any evidence, citing only the internal situation in Germany by saying: "Right here in Europe we are seeing how emergency measures are being used to cut back the rule of law." Deutsche Welle had previously cited UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres as voicing concern over the adoption of repressive measures under the pretext of the coronavirus pandemic. This was a kind of warning against restrictions and violation of human rights under the pretext of the pandemic only in certain countries and either refuses to report on or understates the dire situation in the US or



European countries.

For example, US President Donald Trump recently announced that no media outlet is allowed to independently publish news and statistics about the pandemic, and several cases of cover-up in the early weeks of the outbreak of the virus in the United States became headline news and even led to a legal dispute between the executive of the Erie County and the governor of New York. Erie County Executive Mark Poloncarz in a press conference accused the governor of New York Andrew Cuomo of breaking the law by revealing the number of Erie County residents being monitored for possible exposure to the coronavirus.

"The state violated the law," Poloncarz said. "We've been told that we can't disclose that." This instance shows the extent of the role of the US government's delay in disclosing information on the widespread outbreak of the coronavirus in the US and was, in fact, a clear structured violation of the freedom of the press.

In spite of that, the Reporters without borders (RSF) website claimed in a report

that China is ranked 177th and Iran 173rd in censorship of information related to coronavirus outbreaks in their countries, while there is no information in the report about how the research was conducted and what kind of criteria and scales was considered for the ranking. In the RSF report, similar to the claims by the UN chief and the German foreign minister, the risk posed by countries in opposition to European governments has been exaggerated and the report is clearly biased in favor of the political angle of the other side. Press Deputy Minister of Islamic Guidance: German FM must present evidence We asked the Press Deputy Minister of Culture and Islamic Guidance Mohammad Khodadadi about the sources of the information used in the RSF report, and what documents had convinced the RSF that the freedom of the press in those countries, including Iran, was restricted. Based on what information has Mr. Maas taken this stance (against Iran)?

This you should ask the German foreign minister himself. If there is any evidence, he should present it to us as well. I'm also

bewildered based on what information the German officials have made such a claim!

Do you think there is a kind of psychological warfare going on against Iran by the German government?

I think the German government's intelligence sources are in disarray. There are only two possible scenarios here: either the information they received was incorrect or they do not actually have any information and just wanted to take a position without basing it on a source, which is also a wrong move to make. I expect the German embassy in Iran to have at least explained the real situation to their own foreign minister. The embassy should at least send him real information and documents.

Has any journalist been arrested amid the pandemic? Has the activity of any journalist been restricted due to the coronavirus? Are there any open cases? Have any orders been issued to the media? Has any media been banned from releasing statistical information? If they [German officials] have seen or been reported to of any such instances, they should let us know.

EU regrets US decision to end waivers for Iran's civil nuclear programs

The European Union, France, Germany and the United Kingdom expressed deep regret in a joint statement on Saturday for the US decision to end waivers that allowed countries to cooperate with Iran on civil nuclear projects under the 2015 nuclear deal.

"We deeply regret the US decision to end the three waivers covering key JCPOA nuclear projects in Iran, including the Arak Modernisation Project," the statement said, adding that these projects which were endorsed by UN Security Council resolution 2231, serve the non-proliferation interests of all and provide the international community with assurances of the exclusively peaceful and safe nature of Iranian nuclear activities.

Spokespersons of High Representative of the EU and the Foreign Ministries of France, Germany and the United Kingdom said in the statement that they were consulting with partners to assess the consequences of this decision by the United States.

The EU+E3 underlined that the JCPOA, informally known as Iran nuclear deal, is a key achievement of the global non-proliferation architecture and currently the best and only way to ensure the exclusively peaceful nature of Iran's nuclear program.

US Secretary of State in a message last week said, "Today, I am amending the sanctions waiver for JCPOA-related projects in Iran, effective in 60 days. Iran's continued nuclear escalation makes clear this cooperation must end."

He also blacklisted two more Iranian nuclear officials, saying, "Iran's scientists need to make a choice: pursue peaceful work outside of the proliferation realm, or risk being sanctioned."

China opposes US act to end sanctions waiver against Iran

Chinese Foreign Ministry Spokesperson Zhao Lijian said on Friday that China firmly opposes US recent decision to end sanctions waiver against Iran, adding that it demonstrates its consistent pattern of unilateral and hegemonic practice.

"The US has chosen to stick to its maximum pressure campaign on Iran," Lijian said in his regular press conference, adding, "The US has not only unilaterally withdrawn from the JCPOA in violation of the UNSCR but also ratcheted up efforts to thwart other parties' implementation of the deal."

He noted, "The US' latest decision to end sanctions waiver on relevant nuclear projects hampers the international non-proliferation progress and shared efforts to preserve the JCPOA."

"China firmly opposes US recent decision to end sanctions waiver against Iran, he said, adding, "It demonstrates its consistent pattern of unilateral and hegemonic practice."

"JCPOA as a multilateral agreement endorsed by UN Security Council Resolution 2231, is an important component of the international non-proliferation regime and is essential to peace and stability in the Middle East," he added.

"The Arak reactor conversion is an important part of the JCPOA and a joint project of parties to the agreement. China is ready to work with other parties to continue upholding the deal and safeguarding its own legitimate rights and interests," Lijian said.

Events in Minnesota Expose Human Rights Problems in US: Russia

The unrest in Minnesota demonstrates that serious human rights problems have accumulated in the United States, the Russian Foreign Ministry said in a statement on Friday. "This incident is not the first in the string of incidents exposing lawlessness and unjustified violence by 'guardians of law and order' in the United States," the Russian foreign ministry said in a statement. "Such high-profile crimes are being committed by US police officers too often. The US has evidently accumulated endemic problems in the human rights sphere."

Moscow called upon Washington to thoroughly investigate the incident.

"We call upon the US authorities to return to fulfillment of international obligations, to bring its national legislation into accordance with basic UN principles on the use of force and firearms by law enforcement officers, and, of course, to thoroughly investigate the murder of George Floyd," the ministry said, TASS reported.

In the past years, the United States has seen a series of incidents, in which police officers killed unarmed civilians. Those incidents often triggered large-scale unrests in the country.

In the latest of those incidents, mass protests and unrests broke out in Minnesota and several other US states after a video of George Floyd's May 25 detention was posted online. Floyd, a black man, suspected of paying with fake money at a local shop, was handcuffed by a white police officer, who put him to the ground and pressed his knee firmly against the man's neck. Floyd pleaded that he cannot



breath, but police paid no attention to that. Shortly after, Floyd died in hospital. The four police officers who arrested him were sacked on May 26. One of them - Derek Chauvin, the officer who had his knee on Floyd - was arrested on Friday afternoon and charged with third-degree murder and manslaughter.

Iran to spend 100,000 billion tomans on new national data network: Minister

Iran's Minister of Information and Communications Technology Mohammad-Javad Azari Jahromi said on Saturday that the Government will spend more than 100,000 billion tomans to develop and enhance the national data network and make G4 internet available. Azari-Jahromi made clear that the private sector has spent 19,000 billion tomans on upgrading national data network, but, the Government will spend 100,000 billion tomans on setting up modern national data network and producing G4 internet. He said that the budget has been allocated by the government for expanding the national data network. He also said the goal of the country is to have five million internet TV subscribers. This field of economy is a huge opportunity. Saying the infrastructure of the national network will be completed before summer, he added that the passive defense infrastructure is of great importance too.

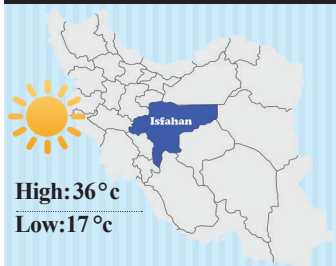

Three Iranian border guards martyred in Sardasht

Three Iranian border guards were martyred in clashes with gunmen in northwestern border area. Rouhani calls on people to coop. with medical staff in fight against coronavirus

Emphasizing that instilling fear, anxiety, and uncertainty about the future of life is not helpful, the Iranian president called on the people to continue to work closely with the country's medical staff in the fight against coronavirus in full compliance with health protocols.

Speaking on Saturday at the meeting of the National Task Force for Fighting Coronavirus, Hassan Rouhani said, "It is necessary that our decision is based on the fact that we must live with a virus for months, with full caution and observance of all health protocols."

The president also said that according to the National Task Force for Fighting Coronavirus, mosques across the country will be open for daily prayers with full implementation of health protocols, and shopping malls will reopen for limited working hours."

At the meeting in which governors-general from all over the country attended via video conference, Rouhani said that coronavirus is still an important issue in the country and has caused many changes in political, social, health, and even cultural issues. "Fortunately, great things have been taken place during the time of coronavirus outbreak, and today we are facing new conditions. Although our lives are more limited and partly through cyberspace, people need to believe that we will not be able to return to the normal conditions as before coronavirus soon," said Rouhani.

"We may have to change our lifestyles for a long time and accept the restrictions and bring some of our lives into the cyberspace," the president said.

Referring to the report and concern of the Minister of Health and Medical Education on not heeding health protocols by the people in some areas, Rouhani said, "Not observing health protocols is a mistake that can endanger the future of our country." Emphasizing the need for communities to keep their distance and keep the infected people away from other members of the society, the President said, "Today, the heroes of our society are the medical staff who are taking steps in this direction with their devotion and self-sacrifice."

Rouhani emphasized, "We have to plan as if we are living with this virus for years and months because there is still no definitive cure for this disease and this virus is spreading in different regions."

The President said that organizing the economy and people's lives is one of the most important issues in this situation and said, "We must live with coronavirus, as in the past, with full caution and observance of care and instructions."

Rouhani added, "We are not only making decisions on a weekly basis, but we are also monitoring and assessing the conditions and decisions on a daily basis, and we are making decisions based on the situation in each region."

Referring to the report presented at the meeting on the number of coronavirus patients in the country, the President said, "This number should not be a cause for concern for the people because this figure is based on tests and is in favor of the future because it separates the infected or the carrier from other people."

Referring to the criteria for measuring the spread of coronavirus in the country, including the situation of hospital beds and the severity of the outbreak of the disease, Rouhani said, "Fortunately, despite the length of the disease in the country, the medical staff was tired, but today, the vitality of the medical staff is very promising, and they are doing their work with strength, spirit, self-sacrifice, and dedication."

The President continued, "Fortunately, we do not have any problems in hospitals in terms of equipment and devices for equipping hospitals and medical staff, and we only ask people to help the country's medical staff with more support and full implementation of health protocols."

Explaining the approvals and decisions of today's meeting of the National Task Force for Fighting Coronavirus, Rouhani said, "In this meeting, decisions were made in the direction of new reopening, which does not mean that the risks are reduced, but we must continue to live with caution and follow the protocols."

The President added, "In today's meeting, according to the request of the religious people of the country to reopen mosques for holding daily prayers, it was decided that congregational prayers be held throughout the country by observing health protocols and keeping distance."

Naghsh-e Jahan Square registered as World Heritage asset

The Horizon 2020, which is a massive EU research and innovation program, has recently registered the 17th-century Naghsh-e Jahan Square in the city of Isfahan as a World Heritage asset with the goal of making world-firsts more known and lucrative.

Naghsh-e Jahan Sq. was laid out in the very early 17th century under the reign of the Safavid ruler, Shah Abbas the Great, to signal the importance of Isfahan as a capital of a powerful empire.

According to the Horizon 2020, the Naghsh-e Jahan Square (locally called "Meidan Emam" and literary meaning "Image of the World") is an open-air educational hub, oriented to preserve tradition and know-how about cultural heritage conservation while promoting entrepreneurship and employment.

"The square is public plaza and group of historic buildings, a UNESCO World Heritage site [since 1979], and it is home to various creative enterprises such as handicraft shops, restaurants, galleries, in addition to mosques and bazaars."

The monumental square has been registered and introduced in the form of a research project as a wealth (asset) of cultural heritage in the world in order to attract more investment for its optimal use.

Director of the Office of International Scientific

Cooperation of the University of Isfahan, Sayyed Komeil Tayyebi announced on Friday that Naghsh-e Jahan Square, over its unique heritage, historical, economic and urban features, has been selected and introduced as an international cultural heritage asset for international organizations in a research project conducted by the European Union, Tehran Times reported.

The square is hemmed on four sides by magnificent buildings: to the east, the Sheikh Lotfollah Mosque; to the west, the palace of Ali Qapu; to the north, the portico of Qeyssariyeh; and to the south, the eminent Imam Mosque.

According to UNESCO, the square was at the heart of the Safavid capital's culture, economy, religion, social power, government, and politics. Its vast sandy esplanade was used for celebrations, promenades, and public executions, for playing polo and for assembling troops.

Foreign Countries Using Iranian AI-Assisted Software for COVID-19 Diagnosis

Several African, American and European countries have employed an Iranian smart software that helps physicians diagnose the novel coronavirus with the help of artificial intelligence by analyzing computed tomography (CT) scans, a Sharif University of Technology professor said. In an address to the 7th Science and Technology Exchange Program (STEP) conference in Tehran, Hamidreza Rabiee said Nigeria, Ghana, Romania, Canada, Germany and Italy have used Iran's homegrown system for diagnosing COVID-19. He said the new

diagnostic method gives results in less than a minute with an accuracy of 96 percent. The system is particularly effective when a large number of patients are taken to a medical center, since the software does not require trained manpower to examine the computed tomography (CT) scans, the Iranian professor noted. The Iranian system was unveiled in early April. Rabiee had announced earlier that the homegrown software's error margin in detection of COVID-19 is much lower than similar ones developed by China and Stanford University in the US. By using the software, medical centers can send online CT scans of lungs of suspicious cases to the researchers and immediately receive the results with high accuracy. The software could also be installed on systems of local medical centers.
