

Bushehr nuclear power plant back on stream after fuel change

After accomplishing its refueling and technical maintenance procedures under the surveillance of Iranian scientists, Bushehr nuclear power plant resumed operation getting connected to Iran's domestic electricity network. Director of Bushehr nuclear plant Reza Banazadeh said this is the first time that the plant has gone under maintenance overhaul without foreign experts' presence. Iranian experts have now proved their capabilities in the maintenance sector, he added.

In mid-April, Bushehr nuclear plant successfully passed the World Association of Nuclear Operators (WANO).

After producing 7,200,000,000 KW nuclear power in the past year, the plant stopped working in mid-April aiming to change reactor fuel.

During this process, one-third of the nuclear fuel will be substituted by new fuel, Banazadeh said before.

The Bushehr facility sits 17 kilometers southeast of the city of Bushehr along the Persian Gulf coast in southwestern Iran. The power plant started operating in 2011 and reached its full capacity the following year.

In 2014, Russia signed a cooperation contract with Iran to help build the second and third Bushehr reactors, which are scheduled for launch in 2024 and 2026, respectively.

Iran has repeatedly enunciated its nuclear program as exclusively civilian, subject to the most intensive UN supervisions ever.

Iran's Methanol Exports to China Rise: Report

Iranian exports to China doubled in April as the economy reopened from the slowdown in February-March to contain the spread of COVID-19, a report said.

Iran's volumes to China rose to 414,000t, accounting for about 40pc of the 1mn t that China imported in April, Argus Media reported.

Iran is the largest exporter of methanol to China, supplying about 40pc of its annual imports. China is the world's largest importer and accounts for some 60pc of global consumption. The country imported 10mn t of methanol in 2019.

Iranian net methanol capacity has almost doubled in the past two years to about 12.2mn t/yr in 2020, with the start of two new units this year.

Pars Kimiya and Bushehr, both located in Assaluyeh and each with methanol capacity of 1.65mn t/yr, began commercial production in the past few months. There was no confirmation from both producers, but several market participants mentioned the start-ups.

Iranian producer Kaveh started production in 2019 at its 2.3mn t/yr unit in Dayyar. SPII-owned Marjan began production at its Assaluyeh-based 1.65mn t/yr plant in August 2018.

NPC plans to diversify butane chain items

The first project in the butane chain in Mahshahr will be ready for operation with the aim of commercial production of three important and new items, parallel with planning for realization of the second petrochemical leap in Iran.

According to the National Petrochemical Company (NPC), the countdown has started for the second leap in the petrochemical industry of Iran as the first project to complete the butane chain will be put into operation in Mahshahr, southwestern Iran.

Amirkabir Petrochemical Plant is one of the successful experiences of using butane as feedstock in the petrochemical industry of Iran. Given this, Ibn Sina Petrochemical Plant is to be launched to be fed by butane.

Iran has planned for the second petrochemical leap which will be realized by 2021 or early 2022 to bring its production capacity production capacity to 100 million tons per year from currently 66 mt/y.

Once operational, the plant will supply maleic anhydride, isobutane and normal butane in Mahshahr.

Ibn Sina Petrochemical Plant is fed by roughly 71,000 tons of butane from Bandar Imam Petrochemical Plant.

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Calls for Promoting Tech Ecosystem to Bolster Domestic Production

State and private institutions should jointly contribute to boosting startups and knowledge-based companies that have a huge untapped potential.



"Startups can boost domestic production and curb the country's reliance on foreign resources," the head of Iran's

Municipalities and Village Administrators said.

Mehdi Jamalinejad added that a new generation of entrepreneurs with totally different working strategies and levels of innovation are expanding their role in the domestic economy, ISNA reported.

"If this human treasury is employed in more executive and managerial roles, knotty problems facing the country will hopefully be solved more quickly and efficiently," he said.

"Industrial and urban managers should start counting on the young talented generation and slash their dependency on the government's financial assistance and oil revenues." Jamalinejad noted that this could only be possible if the technology ecosystem in the country receives a deserving amount of attention and support.

Babak Dinparast, a deputy interior minister, told reporters that the ground should be prepared for knowledge-based companies and startups to expand their roles in the domestic economy and cut unnecessary imports. He said a list of over 4,000 imported raw materials with no domestically-made substitute have been prepared by the ministry.

"We are planning to introduce these materials in a small exhibition and invite all tech firms and knowledge-based companies from around



the country to analyze the possibility of their localization," he said.

Dinparast noted that raw materials needed in different industrial fields are currently imported from 40 countries. Iranian entrepreneurs and tech units can definitely produce quality equivalents and cut the imports' capital flight, he added.

Production Is Solution The nationwide call is in line with the motto of the Iranian New Year (started March 20). Leader of Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei has named the new Iranian year, which began on March 20, the year of "Boosting Production" to help shore up Iran's sanctions-hit economy without relying on other countries.

"This year, production is the main and pivotal issue because an increase in production will help solve livelihood problems and unemployment, and make the country independent of foreigners and enemies. It can also help resolve the problem of the national currency's devaluation to a great extent," the Leader was quoted as saying by his website.

US President Donald Trump's pullout from the 2015 international nuclear deal with Tehran last year and subsequent reimposition

of financial, industrial and energy sanctions has sent the rial into a tailspin.

The weak currency, galloping inflation and diminishing purchasing power have been vexing Iranians in recent months.

"Economic challenges such as the decline in production and the currency's value can be partly attributed to economic mismanagement, which should be fixed," he said, reiterating that boosting production is key to solving problems besetting the country.

Solutions for Streamlining Startup Growth Knowledge-based companies and startups are facing numerous hardships.

Iran's Vice President for Science and Technology Sorena Sattari, a staunch supporter of startups, earlier suggested several measures to obviate their problems. Sattari emphasized the necessity of helping the growth of tech units in the country and said knowledge-based firms and startups need not grapple with basic requirements.

"Tech units should not be worried about the lack of a workplace. In case there is any incomplete or abandoned building, my office will finance their restoration for startup use," he said.

"Insurance and taxes should be waived for tech units. Establishing an office to specifically address such issues can help them get rid of frustrating processes and extra expenses."

The vice president stressed that financial resources should be adequate to meet the units' financial needs in the form of loans and grants. Sattari emphasized that promoting a knowledge-based economy is the most efficient and affordable strategy to address the current economic headwinds and remove impediments in the way of boosting domestic production.

For promoting a knowledge-based economy, Iranian officials believe that the conventional oil-based economic system should be upgraded and the country's dependence on natural resource revenues must be minimized.

To achieve this aim, authorities have been taking measures to support tech firms and startups, boost Iranian startups and develop the technology ecosystem. Establishing shared workplaces and offering financial aid are among services offered to knowledge-based units besides technical, legal and commercial consultancy.

Iran keen on dairy and aquaculture exports to Russia

Iranian Ambassador to the Russian Federation Kazem Jalali said in a meeting with Head of the Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Supervision Sergei Dankvert on Tuesday that Iran is keen on dairy and aquaculture exports to Russia. According to IRNA, Jalali and Dankvert discussed issues related to resolving existing obstacles and developing economic cooperation. Other topics discussed

in the meeting were the issuance of licenses to Iranian companies which are interested in export of dairy and aquaculture products to Russia. In this regard, they decided that the representative of the Russian party and the representative of the Iranian Veterinary Company get in touch for coordination and review the obstacles and take action to remove them as soon as possible.



Envoy: Australia interested in trade relations with Tehran

Australian Ambassador to Iran Lyndall Sachs said on Tuesday that despite current complexities, Australia is interested in enhanced trade ties with Iran.

Sachs made the remarks Tuesday in a meeting with Advisor to Speaker of Iranian Parliament for International Affairs Hossein Amir Abdollahian.

Referring to considerable number of Iranian students and elites studying in Australia, she said that they have significant share in promoting science in the world.

She also pointed to Australia 70-80 percent share of agricultural products and exports through sea, saying maritime freedom and security is of importance for Australia.

Australia understands Iran's major role in preserving regional security, she noted.

Referring to Australian forces advisory presence in Iraq and Afghanistan for training military forces in these countries, Sachs said that Australia is willing to help maintain international peace and stability.

Australia does not interfere in internal affairs of other countries, she said, adding that the country holds talks with parties and plays its part.

Elsewhere in her remarks, the Australian ambassador described parliamentary cooperation and presence of the members of parliamentary delegations in international parliamentary meetings as good opportunity for reinforcing international cooperation.

Meanwhile, Amir Abdollahian said Iran-Australia relations are excellent and constructive but they fall short of the high capacities of the two countries.

He hoped for promoting relations in parliamentary, political and economic fields.

Referring to complicated regional crises and escalation of crises by the US creating military coalitions, he described them as nonconstructive.

Pompeo Compares John Bolton to Edward Snowden

John Bolton's explosive tell-all account of his time as National Security Adviser is comparable to Edward Snowden's disclosure of state-backed mass surveillance of US citizens, US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said Monday.

Pompeo's comments come the night before the release of Bolton's book "The Room Where It Happened," which contains many damning allegations against US President Donald Trump.

"Frankly, the information he has released puts criminal liability squarely on him," the top US diplomat told Fox News. "We all saw what's happened when people leak classified information like Edward Snowden. What John Bolton did here is not dissimilar to that," Pompeo said, AFP reported.

Edward Snowden is a former US intelligence contractor who revealed in 2013 that US agents from the National Security Agency (NSA) were carrying out widespread surveillance on citizens.

Snowden has been living in exile in Russia since his revelation. He has been charged in the US with espionage and theft of state secrets and faces up to 30 years in prison.

"This kind of information getting out, it presents real risk and real harm to the United States of America," Pompeo added.

Bolton's book is an account of his 17 months serving as National Security Adviser.

The book contends that Trump is not "fit for office" and describes the president "pleading" with his Chinese counterpart President Xi Jinping to help boost his chances of re-election in November.

Over the past few days, Trump and his team, including Pompeo, have vacillated between two courses of action: denouncing the book as "fiction," but also claiming it is full of highly sensitive, classified information.

Claims Raised in IAEA Resolution on Iran Illegal: Speaker

Speaker of the Iranian Parliament Mohammad Baqer Qalibaf slammed the illegitimate claims that the International Atomic Energy Agency's Board of Governors has raised against Iran in a recent resolution.

"The claims raised in the IAEA resolution are not legal, and Russia also adopted a decisive stance on it," Qalibaf said in a meeting with Russian Ambassador Levan Jagarian in Tehran on Monday.

The speaker also called for the expansion of parliamentary ties between Tehran and Moscow, saying the next meeting of Supreme Commission of Cooperation between the Russian Duma and the

Iranian Parliament should pursue efforts to promote economic interaction.

Qalibaf also hailed the consultations between Tehran and Moscow for the settlement of the crisis in Syria, reiterating that the Syrian conflict would be resolved only politically.

For his part, the Russian envoy said the anti-Iran allegations in the recent IAEA resolution were in contravention of law, saying, "Support for Iran from Russia and the friendly state of China in this regard will continue."

Speaking at a press conference on Monday, Russia's Foreign Ministry spokeswoman said the recent adoption of an anti-Iran resolution by the Board of Governors of the IAEA is inconsistent with claims by the three European signatories to the JCPOA that they are committed to

their obligations under the accord.

"Reassurances of British, German and French colleagues that they are committed to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) and looking for ways to minimize the negative effect of American sanctions against Iran run counter to their actions to heighten tensions surrounding the Iranian nuclear program at the IAEA as well as speculations about triggering the dispute resolution mechanism under article 36 of the JCPOA," Maria Zakharova said.



Poll: Biden Leads Trump by More than 20 Points on Race, Policing

Presumptive Democratic nominee Joe Biden leads US President Donald Trump by more than 20 points on race and policing, which have become top issues on the minds of voters amid nationwide protests against police brutality.



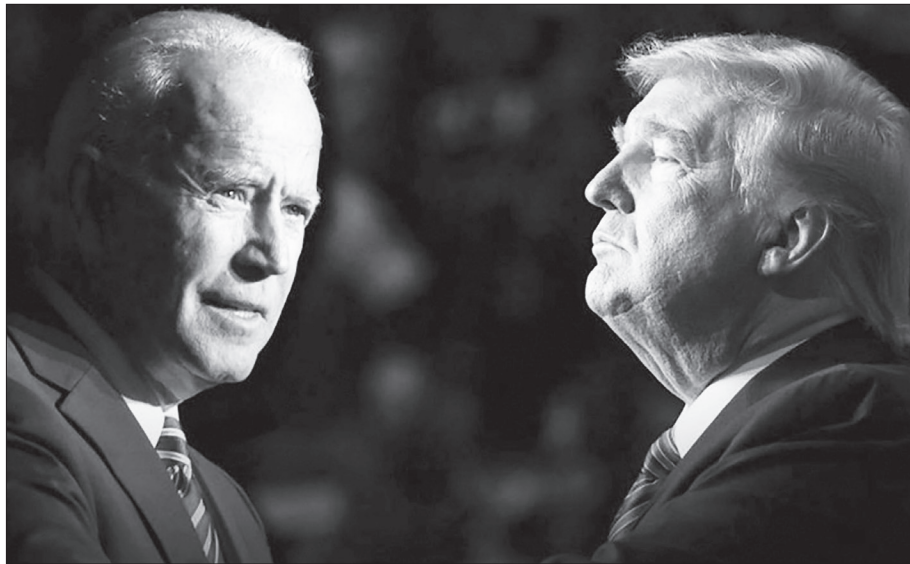
The latest Harvard CAPS-Harris Poll finds that 61 percent of voters say Biden would be better at solving issues of race and

policing, compared to 39 percent who said Trump. Sixty-two percent of voters say Biden would do a better job of bringing the country together following weeks of protests over the death of George Floyd while in police custody.

And 53 percent of voters say Biden would do better at establishing law and order, compared to 47 percent for Trump. Race relations is now tied with the economy as the second most important issue for voters, behind the coronavirus.

Trump's job approval rating on race and policing is at 43 percent positive, the same as his overall job approval rating in the poll. Fifty-three percent of voters oppose Trump's handling of the protests, although a majority, 57 percent said the president was right to call the National Guard in to deal with protesters in Washington, DC.

"Biden did very well on being someone who could bring the country together compared to President Trump and so Trump's overall response, despite support for the guard and even the military, has fallen short as his numbers have definitely



declined," said Mark Penn, polling director for the Harvard CAPS-Harris survey.

The poll found deep racial divisions over policing in the US but there is broad support for both the police and the Black Lives Matter movement.

Sixty percent have a favorable view of the police, while 55 percent view Black Lives Matter favorably.

A plurality, 45 percent, say they personally support the aims and policies of Black Lives Matter, compared to 33 percent who oppose them and 22 percent who don't know.

Nearly two-thirds of voters say they believe the police mostly operate fairly and are unbiased, including 73 percent of white people. But 70 percent of black people said police are biased and operate unfairly.

Fifty-six percent said police misconduct against black people is fairly common. Whites are evenly split on that question, but 85 percent of black Americans said it is common.

A strong majority, 72 percent, said the police should not be defunded.

Forty-six percent said police funding should remain the same, 28 percent said funding should be increased and 26 percent said it should be decreased.

A plurality of voters, 47 percent, said the police should undergo major reforms or restructuring, including 53 percent of white people and 80 percent of black people.

Forty-six percent overall said the police only need minor restructuring or improved training. There is overwhelming support for all police to wear body cameras, for a national registry of disciplined officers, to ban the use of chokeholds, and to strip the police of immunity from civil suits.

Fifty-eight percent of voters said racism is systematic and pervasive in the United States.

"The poll shows tremendous amount of support for both black lives matter and the police," Penn said. "They want police reform, not defunding. They support broad police reforms but don't want to cut the number of police. They recognize significant police misconduct and systemic racism and also

supported bringing in the National Guard."

A plurality of voters, 47 percent, said the response to riots and looting in major cities has been too soft. Twenty-nine percent said the response has been adequate and 23 percent said it has been too harsh. Sixty-seven percent said protests are an appropriate response to Floyd's death.

Fifty-two percent said they would support the US deploying the military to US cities to control protests that get out of control. The Harvard CAPS/Harris Poll online survey of 1,886 registered voters was conducted June 17-18. It is a collaboration of the Center for American Political Studies at Harvard University and The Harris Poll. The Hill will be working with Harvard CAPS/Harris Poll throughout 2020.

Full poll results will be posted online later this week. The survey is an online sample drawn from the Harris Panel and weighted to reflect known demographics. As a representative online sample, it does not report a probability confidence interval.

Iran's envoy to China hails Beijing's stance on JCPOA

Iran's ambassador to China, Mohammad Keshavarzadeh commended China for objection to anti-Iran resolution passed by the International Atomic Energy Agency Board of Governors, saying Beijing's recent stance against the resolution was decisive and Iran will never forget China's firm stance.

Mohammad Keshavarzadeh made the remarks in a reaction to China Foreign Ministry spokesman Zhao Lijian's remarks about European countries' approach toward Iran's nuclear deal known as the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA).

"E3 Foreign Ministers released a joint statement on Iran and upholding JCPOA commitments. Having quit JCPOA, the US has no right to ask the UNSC to trigger sanctions snapback. We urge the US to return to JCPOA and the UNSC resolution," Lijian said on Monday.

"Beijing's recent stance against IAEA anti-Iran resolution was decisive and Iran will never forget China's firm stance," Mohammad Keshavarzadeh wrote on his official Twitter account, hailing China's stance.

Iran domestically produces over 70% of aircraft, chopper parts: Brig. Gen. Hatami

Iranian Minister of Defense Brigadier General Amir Hatami said that more than 70 percent of aircrafts' and helicopters' parts are manufactured domestically.

Although the Islamic Republic of Iran is not among the countries producing aircraft and helicopter, today, more than 70 percent of parts of aircraft and helicopters are produced inside the country due to the salient achievements gained in the defense industry over the past 40 years, MP Abolfazl Torab quoted the defense minister as saying at a closed session of the Parliament on Tuesday.

Hatami also submitted a comprehensive report on the high defense capability of the country in missile field, manufacturing advanced and sophisticated vessels.

Elsewhere in his remarks, he said that although Iran is not among the countries producing aircrafts and helicopters, we managed to indigenize manufacturing of parts and equipment in these fields.

Islamic Republic of Iran is among the rare countries which managed to attain the technology of manufacturing aircraft parts, minister of defense highlighted.

Islamic Republic of Iran has been equipped with the world's most modern technologies in the field of aerospace and has gained numerous achievements in this regard, Hatami has noted.

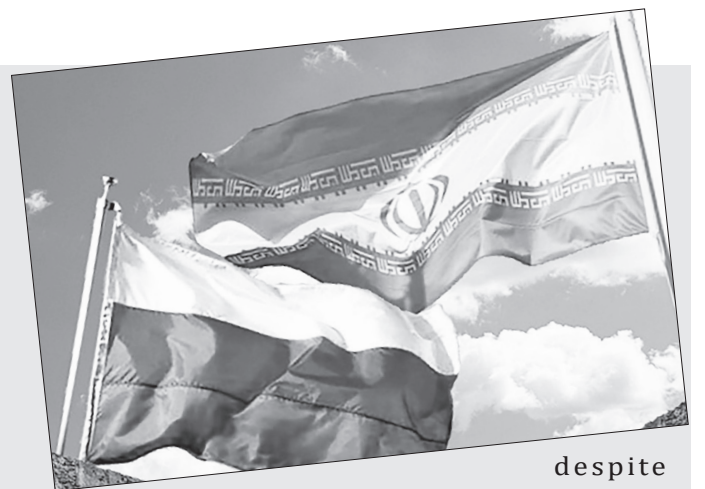
Russia: EU officials do not conform to their commitment to JCPOA

Russia's Foreign Ministry said in a statement that the statements of the EU states about the use of trigger mechanism did not conform to their commitments to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA). The statement, released on Monday evening, said that the foreign ministers of Germany, France, and Britain issued a statement on June 19 expressing their assessment for the implementation of the JCPOA. Some clauses in the statement raise issues about the intentions of European partners in this regard.

The statement said that the Russian side has always valued the efforts of the two countries, Germany and France, members of the European Union, and the United Kingdom, in resolving issues to maintain

JCPOA.

The Russian Foreign Ministry says the main cause of all the problems and shortcomings in the implementation of the nuclear deal with Iran has been the disruptive US act, which unilaterally withdrew from the JCPOA and continues to violate the provisions of Security Council Resolution 2231. European Governments also seem to understand this because they considered as necessary to remind their demands, aspirations, and concerns. However, practical commitment of the British, German and French partners to the JCPOA and the search for solutions would reduce the negative effects of US sanctions on Iran are not compatible with their efforts to the tense situation over the nuclear program in the IAEA and their statements regarding the launch of the trigger mechanism invoking Article 36 of the JCPOA. The European Troika resolution against Iran was approved by the IAEA Board of Governors on Friday,



despite strong opposition from China and Russia. In the resolution, the three European countries, Britain, Germany, and France, with the support of the United States, called on Iran to provide access to IAEA inspectors to the two nuclear sites and to cooperate fully with the agency.

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Chinese Firm Gets Approval to Begin Human Testing for Potential Coronavirus Vaccine

China has approved a coronavirus vaccine candidate developed by Chongqing Zhifei Biological Products' unit to begin human testing, the company said in a filing on Tuesday. The potential vaccine, co-developed by Anhui Zhifei Longcom Biopharmaceutical and the Institute of Microbiology of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, has received a certificate from the National Medical Products Administration to launch clinical trials, Reuters reported. Chinese researchers and companies are testing six experimental shots in humans, and more than a dozen vaccines are in different stages of clinical trials globally against the virus that has killed over 470,000 people. However, none of them have passed large-scale, late-stage phase 3 clinical trials, a necessary step before entering the consumer market.

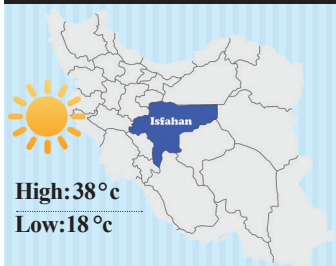

Iran paying above 90% of educational costs of immigrants: Official

Iran is paying some 93% of educational costs of foreign citizens living in the country while international organizations are only paying only seven percent of the costs, a senior immigration official said on Tuesday.

Mehdi Mahmoudi, the director-general of the Bureau for Aliens and Foreign Immigrants Affairs of the Ministry of Interior, told IRNA that most immigrants living in Iran are Afghan citizens.

"It's nearly 40 years that the Afghan immigrants have come to Iran and some of them are somehow regarded as Iranian citizens," the official said. Some 1.7 million immigrants are currently living in Iran, the official added.

IAEA inspects Iran's nuclear centers 33 times a year: Expert

Russia's Foreign Ministry spokeswoman said the recent adoption of an anti-Iran resolution by the Board of Governors of the IAEA is inconsistent with claims by the three European signatories to the JCPOA that they are committed to their obligations under the accord.

"Reassurances of British, German and French colleagues that they are committed to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) and looking for ways to minimize the negative effect of American sanctions against Iran run counter to their actions to heighten tensions surrounding the Iranian nuclear program at the IAEA as well as speculations about triggering the dispute resolution mechanism under article 36 of the JCPOA," Maria Zakharova said during her weekly press conference on Monday. She added, "The adoption of IAEA Board of Governors resolution on Iran was not dictated by the reality of applying guarantees in Iran."

"We are certain that all questions arising, including the agreement of access to facilities that the agency is interested in, could be resolved in the framework of standard procedures of cooperation between states and the IAEA Secretariat." "It is not coincidental that the resolution, in the end, was not supported by states representing more than half of the world's population, including two UN Security Council permanent members," Zakharova stressed.

The Russian Foreign Ministry also emphasized that Moscow along with Chinese partners warned the sponsors in advance that this resolution would be counterproductive, as it will only do harm. "We repeatedly urged against playing up to backers of the policy of maximum pressure on Iran which completely discredited itself both politically and practically," she said.

The United Kingdom, Germany and France understand that the root cause of all faults in implementing the JCPOA on the Iranian nuclear program has been and remains the US actions, the Russian spokeswoman said, She recalled that on June 19 heads of diplomatic agencies of these countries issued a statement representing their view of state of affairs and prospects of implementing the Iranian nuclear deal. "The root cause of all difficulties and faults in the process of implementation of the Iranian nuclear deal has been and remains the destructive actions of the United States who unilaterally quit the JCPOA and to this day continues to systematically violate demands of UN Security Council Resolution 2231," Zakharova pointed out. "Clearly, this is understood in European capitals, since they deemed it necessary to remind [the world] about their regrets and concerns in this regard."

Moscow is calling on European parties to the JCPOA to confirm their commitment to the agreement on the eve of the deal's fifth anniversary, the diplomat said. "We believe it is vital that all current parties (to the JCPOA) reaffirmed their unwavering commitment to the high goals set in the JCPOA," the diplomat noted. "The great occasion to do that seems to be July 14, the fifth anniversary of signing the JCPOA. We are urging the European parties to the comprehensive agreements to seize this opportunity to return to the unifying agenda and continue fighting for the common good."

The 35-member IAEA board passed the resolution on Friday, demanding access to two old places they claim nuclear work may have been done there.

Nine countries out of 35 members to the IAEA board did not vote for the resolution. China and Russia voted against the resolution and Thailand, Mongolia, Niger, South Africa, India, Pakistan and the Republic of Azerbaijan abstained to vote.

U.S expert predicts "there will be more violent" If Trump wins reelection

A US political science professor told ILNA news agency that Iran nuclear deal (JCPOA) certainly looks dead in a Trump presidency and he is unlikely to reverse his "maximum pressure" campaign this year, meaning sanctions will not be lifted.

"Part of the problem is Trump, but the U.S has a long history of meddling in Latin American affairs. Biden has called Maduro a 'tyrant' and he supports stronger targeted multilateral sanctions against certain domestic actors."

In an exclusive interview, the political science professor at Louisville University Rodger A. Payne said "If Trump is re-elected; I expect greater domestic turmoil that could turn much more violent." The U.S professor believed that it appears Trump will not be re-elected, though the chance is obviously not zero and adding "A Biden presidential administration would likely be very interested in a return to the agreement, but it will have many domestic and foreign policy problems to fix and I'm not certain how high a priority JCPOA will be in the first year or so." He added that However, if the US returns to a relatively normal period, then it is possible a re-elected Trump could be convinced to negotiate a new wider security and trade deal with Iran. "Trump demonized China for many years, and continues to do so in regards to the coronavirus, but he also concluded a trade deal with China several months ago and will campaign based on this during the next few months."

Payne who has researched multilateralism, international security, and democratization of global politics, also confirmed that the prospects for a new deal with Iran are far from guaranteed,

partly because of the views of Republican foreign policy personnel, but it is not impossible in a second Trump term.

Referring to U.S airstrike of Iranian military commander Qasem Soleimani, he said "The U.S Congress voted to prohibit war with Iran. Almost no one wants a new US war, especially in the Middle East."

"A number of Republican Senators voted for the measure, meaning Trump cannot even assure the political support of his base should he attempt to escalate tensions towards conflict." Answering a question about why the United States opposed sending oil to Venezuela, the political science professor confirmed "Part of the problem is Trump, but the U.S has a long history of meddling in Latin American affairs. Biden has called Maduro a 'tyrant' and he supports stronger targeted multilateral sanctions against certain domestic actors."

He went on to answer another question about the impact of unilateral U.S sanctions on ordinary citizens, said "Personally, I've always believed that sanctions (whether against Iran or Venezuela or any state) should be 'smart' -- narrowly targeted on the elite perpetrators of the policies the US (or world) is trying to change." "Moreover, unilateral sanctions have a very poor historical record in international politics. Additionally, in the case of Iran, U.S allies and trade partners do not want to be compelled to comply with US interests via secondary sanctions," the international analyst added.

Iran's Parliament Speaker Condemns US Sanctions against Syria

Iranian Parliament Speaker Mohammad Baqer Qalibaf denounced the latest round of American coercive economic measures against Syria, saying the new sanctions indicate Washington's failure to push ahead with its military plots against the Arab country. "Enemies of Syria, Iran and the resistance axis were desperate because of their failure in their

terrorist and military war against Syria, so they moved to impose economic and coercive unilateral measures, and this is evidence to their failure in their plots," Qalibaf said on Monday in a meeting with Syrian Ambassador to Iran Adnan Mahmoud, SANA reported. Syria has always been and will remain on the front line of the resistance axis, he added, reaffirming Iran's continued support for the Arab country. For his part, Mahmoud congratulated Qalibaf on his election as the speaker of the Iranian

Parliament, stressing the importance of enhanced ties between the two nations, in the field economy in particular. Recently, the US State Department and the Treasury said 39 Syrian individuals, including President Bashar al-Assad and his wife, had been designated for a load of new economic and travel sanctions. The law, known as the Caesar Act, places anyone who does business with the 39 named individuals and government entities in the crosshairs of the US Treasury.

Moscow is calling on European parties to the JCPOA to confirm their commitment to the agreement on the eve of the deal's fifth anniversary, the diplomat said.
