دلان‌های گندم، مشغول بازار گرمی هستند؟

تضمینی خرید گندم با تصویب هیئت وزیران، قیمت تضمینی خرید گندم با رشد ۴۰ درصدی نسبت به سال گذشته اعلام شد اما نرخ تعیینی بای دلان را به بازار خرید باز کرده است.

گندم یکی از مهمترین محصولاتی است که برای کشاورزان اهمیت بالایی برخوردار است و چنانچه کشاورز قیمت مناسبی جهت فروش محصول خود نداشته باشد، امکان رقابت و پس‌انداز از دست می‌دهد و منابع مالی مناسبی نیز برای فعالیت‌های خود در اختیار نخواهد داشت. در این میان ضربه نخست به خودکفایی تولید گندم است.

کارشناسان اقتصادی معتقدند که در اغلب کشورهای جهان به‌ویژه کشورهای توسعه‌یافته حمایت از بخش کشاورزی به‌عنوان یکی از سیاست‌های پایدار و راهبردی است. از جمله دلایل اجرای چنین سیاست‌هایی را می‌توان پایین بودن سطح درآمد بخش کشاورزی و نوسانات آن در مقایسه با سایر بخش‌های اقتصادی و دستیابی به خودکفایی در تولید محصولات کشاورزی برای بهبود امنیت غذایی دانست.

به نظر می‌رسد یکی از مزیت‌های خرید تضمینی امسال افزایش ۴۰ درصدی قیمت خرید تضمینی گندم باشد که از یک‌هزار و ۷۰۰ تومان برای هر کیلو در سال ۹۸ به ۲ هزار و ۵۰۰ تومان رسیده، اما مسئولان و فعالان کشاورزی معتقدند سیاست‌های نادرست دولت در خرید تضمینی و قیمت اعلامی بای دلان را به بازار خرید باز می‌کند و پایداری تولید را متزلزل می‌کند.

فعالان بخش کشاورزی معتقدند: سال گذشته دولت گندم را با نرخ یک هزار و ۷۰۰ تومان خریداری کرد در شرایطی که قیمت بازار ۲ هزار و ۲۰۰ تومان بود؛ دلان با چند ماه انبارداری بیش از میلیاردی پول به جیب زده‌اند. این شرایط امسال هم دوباره در حال تکرار است. براساس این گزارش گندم کاران ایران تا پایان تیر امسال بیش از ۶ میلیون تن گندم به سیلوهای دولت تحویل داده‌اند و قرار است افزایش خرید تضمینی گندم و به حداقل رساندن واردات در سال جدید، نیاز ۱۱ تا ۱۰ میلیون تنی گندم در مصرف داخلی را تأمین کند.

به گفته پیمان فیروزنیا، مدیر زراعت سازمان جهاد کشاورزی استان اصفهان تاکنون ۹۸ هزار و ۵۰۰

تن گندم آبی و ببری در استان خرید تضمینی شده است، اگرچه پیش‌بینی تولید حدود ۳۰۰ هزار تن گندم در اصفهان می‌شود، اما به دلیل اینکه نیاز استان حدود ۲ برابر تولید گندم موجود است، بنابراین ناچار به واردات از دیگر استان‌ها و خارج کشور هستیم.

قانون تضمین خرید محصولات اساسی کشاورزی، در سال ۱۳۶۸ تصویب و در سال‌های ۱۳۷۲ و ۱۳۸۳ اصلاحیه‌هایی در آن صورت گرفت. در تاریخ ۳۰ خرداد ۱۳۸۴ هم دو تبصره دیگر به قانون تضمین خرید سال‌های ۱۳۶۸ و ۱۳۸۳ اضافه شد. از جمله در تبصره ۶ قانون، دولت موظف

شد تا قیمت خرید تضمینی محصولات اساسی کشاورزی را در هر سال زراعی به گونه‌ای تعیین کند که میزان افزایش آن هیچ‌گاه از نرخ تورم اعلام شده از سوی بانک مرکزی جمهوری اسلامی ایران در همان سال کمتر نباشد.

قانون خرید تضمینی محصولات کشاورزی این اختیار را برای تولیدکنندگان قائل شده که محصول تولیدی خود را در بازار آزاد با هر قیمتی به فروش برسانند و چنانچه در عرضه محصول موفق نشدند دولت متکلف است با نرخ خرید تضمینی، محصول آن‌ها را برای جلوگیری از ضرر و زیان احتمالی خریداری کند. اما در شرایط کنونی دولت کشاورزان را متکلف می‌کند با نرخ تعیین شده گندم را به مراکز دولتی بدهد.

از طرفی با وجود وعده و وعیدهای مختلف مسئولان، مطالبات گندم‌کاران همچنان تا تأخیر پرداخت می‌شود و نرخ‌های پیشنهادی بالاتر دلان در کشاورزان در کنار دغدغه‌های معیشتی و هزینه‌های بالای مواد اولیه تولید محصولات کشاورزی، نه تنها خرید تضمینی دولت را با چالش مواجه می‌کند بلکه استمرار این روند، آینده تولید این محصول استراتژیک را در معرض خطر قرار

می‌دهد. به گفته کارشناسان کشاورزی اگر تورم ادوات تولیدی کشور در زمینه‌های دیگر مانند خوراک دام صرف شود و با از سوی واسطه‌ها خریداری و به خارج کشور قاچاق شود و اینکه کاهش تمایل کشاورزان به کاشت گندم، مساله خودکفایی تولید را در سال‌های آینده تحت‌الشعاع قرار دهد.

دولتمردان به تشخیص خود عمل می‌کنند مدیرعامل کانون خبرگان کشاورزی اصفهان پیرامون اینکه چرا هر ساله شاهدیم که نرخ خرید تضمینی گندم با چالش‌هایی روبه‌رو است، گفت: صحیح قانون را در برنامه ندارند و به تشخیص خود عمل می‌کنند و اهمیتی نمی‌دهند که موارد قانونی چیست و چگونه باید اجرائی شود.

اسفندیار امینی اظهار داشت: متأسفانه بیشترین قانون شکنی را در کشور دولت‌ها دارند و این خلاف قانون است و چنین اقداماتی ضرر آن فقط نصیب کشاورزان می‌شود و برای دولتمردان هم ضرر کشاورز مورد اهمیت نیست، همانطور که حق کشاورزان هم برای آن‌ها مهم تلقی نمی‌شود. او افزود: مادر این مسائل هنوز دچار مشکل هستیم، اما متأسفانه کارها در مسیر صحیح خود اجرائی نمی‌شود، گندم محصولی نیست که بگویم تازه در کشور کاشته می‌شود، بلکه زمان کاشت و برداشت آن مشخص است و باید اعتبارات لازم آن قبل توسط دولت و در مجلس تعیین شود تا وزارت جهاد کشاورزی بتواند اقدامات قانونی آن را اجرائی کند.

Minister urges facilitating use of modern equip. at airports

Iranian Minister of Roads and Urban Development called for facilitating the use of modern equipment and machinery at airports of the country. Speaking on Monday on the sidelines of the unveiling ceremony of domestically-manufactured Mobile Air Traffic Control (ATC) Tower, he stated, "focusing on domestic production and taking advantage of domestic capabilities have been turned into an organizational belief and culture at the Ministry of Roads and Urban Development."

Yesterday, the fourth package of domestic productions in the rail sector was delivered to the Islamic Republic of Iran Railways and today, the first advanced mobile air traffic control tower was delivered to Iran Airports Company (IAC) by SAIran, an electronics company affiliated to Iranian Ministry of Defense, showing that Iran enjoys high capability and potential to take giant stride despite sanctions imposed against the country, Eslami emphasized. Under such circumstances that the country is grappling with sanctions, opportunity created for the country as a result of sanctions should be used optimally for progress and development, he stressed.

The first domestically-manufactured air traffic control tower was unveiled on Monday in the presence of Minister of Defense Brigadier General Amir Hatami and Minister of Roads and Urban Development Mohammad Eslami.

Iran, Iraq resume trade activity in Mandali Border Crossing

Islamic Republic of Iran and Iraq resumed their trade activities in Mandali (Soomar) Border Crossing which had been halted for about five months ago due to the outbreak of coronavirus pandemic, COVID-19. Mazen al-Khuzai Director of Mandali Region on Sun. revealed the reopening of Mandali Border Crossing, third Iraq border point, for trade activity between Iran and Iraq, according to al-Malumah.

Accordingly, dozens of trucks, passing from Iranian border, headed towards Mandali Border Crossing, the official added.

Mandali Border Crossing is located in the vicinity of Soomar Border Market place, Kermanshah province. Iraqi Prime Minister Mustafa al-Kadhimi, in his visit to Diyala Governorate on July 11, reopened Mandali Border Crossing for trade activity with Islamic Republic of Iran.

Iran's export to Eurasia increased by 17 percent

Head of Trade Promotion Organization of Iran (TPOI) Hamid Zadboum said that Iran's total exports to Eurasia has increased 17% compared to the same period last year.

He made the remarks on Sunday noting that Iran's total exports to Eurasia after the implementation of the agreement that is from October 27 2019 to June 19 2020 has amounted to \$681 million, which has increased by 17% compared to the corresponding period last year. "Iran's total imports from Eurasia until June 19, 2020, has reached to \$1.736 billion, which has increased by 13% compared to the same period last year," he added.

"The total volume of trade between the two countries stands at \$2.417 billion, which has increased by 14% compared to the same period last year. Despite the outbreak of coronavirus and the decline in international trade in recent months, this growth rate indicates the stability of trade between Iran and the Eurasian Economic Union and the ability to develop economic relations," he maintained.

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Hariri urges sustainable financing in Iran-China Coop.

Chairman of Iran-China Joint Chamber of Commerce and Industry said the Islamic Republic of Iran needs a sustainable financing in all-out transactions.



Majid Reza Hariri said that the two countries are complementary in economic exchanges and today,

the country needs sustainability for financing and participating in all-out exchanges.

Conclusion of a 25-Year Cooperation Document with the People's Republic of China can materialize the said objective, he stressed, according to IRNA.

The signing of this cooperation agreement between Iran and China is bilateral, he said, adding, "on the one hand, China wants the energy that the Islamic Republic of Iran is



able to supply and Iran can take advantage of Chinese technologies on the other hand."

Cooperating in the field of transferring energies like oil, gas, petrochemical, and mines constitutes the main framework of Iran's economic agreement with China in the short- and long-term, he said, adding, "presently, about 70% of oil, mineral and nonmetallic

products, as well as 27 percent of non-oil exports of the country, is traded with China without this agreement."

Elsewhere in his remarks, Hariri pointed to China as Iran's first trade partner in the field of exports and added, "Iran's current economic situation needs the development of infrastructures and China can help Iran in this field

greatly, for, China is the largest buyer of reserves in most mineral and energy products in the world."

He pointed to a negative wave of media hype and positions of Western countries and the United States on the signing of a 25-year agreement between Iran and China and said, "these oppositions indicate that signing this agreement will be in Iran's favor."

Gold hits record high as U.S.-China ties worsen

Gold hit an all-time high on Monday as tit-for-tat consulate closures in China and the United States rattled investors, boosting the allure of safe haven assets, although sentiment was mixed with tech gains supporting some Asian stocks. MSCI's ex-Japan Asia-Pacific index rose 1.3% as Taiwan's TSMC, Asia's third-largest company by market capitalisation, rose almost 10%.

The chipmaker's gains boosted other tech stocks in the region and came after rival Intel signalled it may give up manufacturing its own components due to delays in new 7 nanometer chip technology.

Also soothing sentiment, Chinese shares eked out gains after big falls late last week, with CSI 300 index rising 0.5%.

S&P 500 futures were last up 0.4% in choppy trade while Japan's Nikkei fell 0.5%, resuming trade after a long weekend and catching up with falling global shares late last week.

Global shares had lost steam last week after Washington ordered China's consulate in Houston to close, prompting Beijing to react in

kind by closing the U.S. consulate in Chengdu. U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo took fresh aim at China last week, saying Washington and its allies must use "more creative and assertive ways" to press the Chinese Communist Party to change its ways.

"U.S. President (Donald) Trump used to say China's President Xi Jinping is a great leader. But now Pompeo's wording is becoming so aggressive that markets are starting to worry about further escalation," said Norihiro Fujito, chief investment strategist at Mitsubishi Securities.

Gold rose 1.0% to a record high of \$1,920.9 per ounce, surpassing a peak touched in September 2011, as Sino-U.S. tensions boosted the allure of safe haven assets, especially those not tied to any specific country.

The yellow metal is also helped by aggressive monetary easing adopted by many central banks around the world since the pandemic plunged the global economy into a recession.

Some investors fret such an unprecedented level of money-printing could eventually lead to inflation.

Hopes of a quick U.S. economic recovery are fading as coronavirus infections showed few signs of slowing.

That means the economy could capitulate without fresh support from the government, with some of earlier steps such as enhanced jobless benefits due to expire this month.

Investors hope U.S. Congress will agree on a deal before its summer recess but there are some sticking points including the size of stimulus and enhanced unemployment benefits.

U.S. Treasury Secretary Steve Mnuchin said the package will contain extended unemployment benefits with 70% "wage replacement". Democrats, who control the House of Representatives, want enhanced benefits of \$600 per week to be extended and look to much bigger stimulus compared with the Republicans' \$1 trillion plan.

Investors are looking to corporate earnings from around the world for hints on the pace of recovery in the global economy.

"It looks like rising coronavirus cases are starting to slow down recovery in many countries," said Masahiro Ichikawa, senior strategist at Sumitomo Mitsui DS Asset Management.

Concerns about the U.S. economic outlook started to weigh on the dollar, reversing its inverse correlation with the economic well-being over the past few months.

Iran steel production on positive track despite pandemic

According to the World Steel Association recent release, 'June 2020 crude steel production', Iran's steel production has grown by 10.2 percent.

As Iranian Mines and Mining Industries Development and Renovation Organization announced on Sunday, Iran steel production in the first half of 2020 stood at 13.88 million tons despite the coronavirus outbreak.

In June, Iran's production level surpassed 2.4 million tons, showing a growth of 5.2 percent compared to the same month in the previous year, the Iranian body added.

According to the latest Iranian Steel Producers Association (ISPA), some 7,135,000 tons of steel were produced in the first three months of the current Iranian calendar year (from March 21 to June 20), registering a three percent growth as compared to the last year's corresponding period.

Although the production volume of billet and bloom (steel ingots) in the first three months of the current year decreased, the total production volume of intermediate steel in the country recorded a three percent growth as compared to the same period of last year, the same report confirmed in mid-June. Of total 7,135,000 tons of steel produced in the first quarter of the current year, 4,120,000 and 3,015,000 tons of which related to the billet, bloom and slab respectively.

Due to sanctions, there is no market left for Iranian carpets

The Head of the Union of Textile Carpet Weavers of Iran Mujtaba Araqchi said that if Iranian carpets are sold for \$500 and Indian, Pakistani and Afghan carpets are sold for \$250, then foreign buyers will definitely choose non-Iranian carpets. In an interview with ILNA, the Iranian official added "Currently, the people's purchasing power has decreased." He confirmed that this has a direct impact on the purchase of hand-made carpets in the domestic market, in

addition, 95 percent of the hand-made carpet market is abroad, and due to sanctions, there is almost no market left for Iran. "Now the situation with exports is very bad, spending has decreased, so we are witnessing a terrible decline in both domestic and foreign markets." "Of course, the spread of the coronavirus, in addition to all these factors, has aggravated and seriously affected foreign markets and exports," Araqchi said.

Amir-Abdollahian re-appointed as head Intifada conf.

In a decree, the Speaker of the Iranian Parliament re-appointed Hossein Amir-Abdollahian as Secretary-General of the International Conference in Support of the Palestinian Intifada. "With respect to your religious and revolutionary commitment, valuable background and experience in the field of foreign policy, and in particular in supporting the liberation of the Quds and Palestine, you are appointed to this position and also to be a member of the Board of Trustees of the Palestine International Conference Secretariat," the decree signed by Mohammad Bagher Ghalibafis read.

The 6th International Conference in Support of the Palestinian Intifada was held in Tehran in February 2016, with the presence of the Supreme Leader of the Revolution in the opening ceremony as well as 700 foreign guests, including the world's Speakers of Assemblies, political leaders, and resistance leaders. The Palestinian Secretariat developments in this area in a professional manner, along with parliamentary diplomacy.

According to its Statute, four members of the Parliament plus the Secretary-General constitute the Board of Trustees of the International Conference in Support of the Palestinian Intifada. Earlier, Ghalibaf had also re-appointed Amir-Abdollahian as his Special Adviser for International Affairs.

Iranian Official Urges Negotiated Solution to Karabakh Dispute

Iranian President's Chief of Staff Mahmoud Vaezi called for a peaceful solution to the dispute in the Karabakh region after an escalation of tensions between Armenia and the Republic of Azerbaijan.

In a telephone conversation with foreign policy advisor to president of the Republic of Azerbaijan Hikmat Hajiyev on Sunday, Vaezi said Iran's formal stance on the conflicts and disputes is "supporting the territorial integrity and sovereignty" of the nations. "Tensions in the region would certainly not be in the interest of any

country, and we favor stability, development and progress for all countries, particularly the Republic of Azerbaijan," he added. The Iranian president's chief of staff further stressed the need for the settlement of disputes through peaceful solutions and dialogue. "As a friendly country and neighbor, the Islamic Republic of Iran has always stood by the Republic of Azerbaijan's government and nation and attaches significance to the promotion of ties with that country," Vaezi added. For his part, Hajiyev commended Iran for its clear stances on international conflicts and its respect for the sovereignty of nations, saying, "Iran, as a very important and influential country in the region, has a major role in the settlement of regional problems and disputes." He also highlighted Baku's willingness to boost relations

with Tehran in various fields, particularly the economic ties. Azerbaijan and Armenia, two former Soviet republics, have for decades been locked in a simmering conflict over Karabakh - an Azerbaijani territory seized by Armenian separatists in a bloody war in the 1990s. Some 30,000 people were killed in the conflict, which ended with a fragile truce in 1994. The two sides are still technically at war and have yet to reach a permanent peace agreement on the issue.



Iran will make US regret: Mousavi

The Spokesperson of the Iranian foreign ministry pointed to the recent US harassment of the Iranian airliner in Syria noting that Iran will take the required measures to make the US regret its deed.



In a press conference on Monday, Abbas Mousavi answered various questions about the Islamic Republic's foreign policies.

He condemned the US harassment of a Mahan passenger plane saying that Americans have acted like pirates and done a risky measure. "It was a terrorist and dangerous act and against all the international laws," he underlined.

"The Iranian foreign ministry, Iran Civil Aviation Organization, Judiciary system, and the General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran will take the necessary measures to make the US regret what it has done," he added.

US will not achieve its aim of extending Iran arms embargo. In reaction to the recent remarks of Pompeo about the extension of Arms Embargo on Iran, Mousavi assured that the



US will not reach its preferred target.

On FM Zarif's talks in Moscow

He elsewhere addressed FM Zarif's talks with Russian President Putin and explained that the two sides have conferred on the most important issues and concerns of the two countries in the bilateral, regional and international field and the obtained achievements will be revealed in near future.

The spokesman named Zarif's latest trip to Baghdad as 'fruitful'.

Iran supports Afghan-led peace talks

Mousavi also reiterated that

Iran pays specific attention to Afghan-Afghan talks under the current Afghan government and rejects any foreign interference in Afghan peace talks. He added that Iran will use its specific capacities for resolving tensions in Afghanistan.

Iran's presence in Syria

Addressing the Zionist PM's claims about the presence of Iran in Syria, Mousavi noted that "Iran is present in Syria as an advisor and due to the request of the legitimate Syrian government and nation."

Same as Brian Hook, Netanyahu is a windbag, Mousavi said, adding that the "Existence of the Zionist regime is regarded as

illegitimate by a lot of countries including Iran."

Zionists cannot make any comments about Iran's presence in other countries, he noted. The regime in Tel Aviv is not in the position to tell Iran where and how it should be, highlighted the spokesperson.

On the black box of the Ukrainian airliner

About the decryption of Ukrainian flight's black box in France, the Iranian officials said, "France has the technology to decode the black box of the downed Ukrainian flight and it is not expected to release the achieved data from it unofficially."

US policy failed due to Iran's ideology, resistance economy

Moscow-based political analyst Andrew Korybko believes that the US maximum pressure policy has failed due to the "ideological cohesion of the Iranian people" and their "resistance economy."

Andrew Korybko is a political analyst, journalist, and a member of the expert council for the Institute of Strategic Studies and Predictions at the People's Friendship University of Russia. He specializes in Russian affairs and geopolitics, specifically the US strategy in Eurasia.

His other areas of focus include tactics of regime change, color revolutions, and unconventional warfare used across the world. His book, "Hybrid Wars: The Indirect Adaptive Approach To Regime Change", extensively analyzes the situations in Syria and Ukraine and claims to prove that they represent a new model of strategic warfare being

waged by the US.

In order to shed light on the recent developments in the Middle East, Mehr News reached the American-born, Moscow-based political analyst for an exclusive interview.

When asked to comment on the recent illegal move of the US in Syria during which the country's fighter jets harassed the Iranian airliner Mahan by conducting some dangerous maneuvering close to the passenger plane as it was flying over Syria's strategic al-Tanf region, Korybko said that the US acted very recklessly and could have caused a catastrophe, adding that causing a catastrophe could have been as well one of the reasons why Washington did it.

"The United States has an interest in 'defending' its illegal military presence in Syria and around al-Tanf, and this action has drawn global attention to those interests. If the plane had crashed as a result of this move, then the United States would have tried to find a way to blame Iran for it," he added.

About the US illegal presence in Syria, he said that

Syria is unable to put an end to the illegal military presence of the United States on its soil.

"Russia will not intervene to help Syria," he said, adding "because Moscow's military mission in that country is only to fight terrorism... Iran is Syria's only ally that wants to drive the United States out of Syria."

About the possibility of a coalition in the region formed between Iran and the member states of the Resistance, he said that these countries have a legitimate right to form a coalition, but it is very dangerous to do so.

"Because Israel is unlikely to allow the Iranian Air Force to regularly escort civilian aircraft very close to its borders," he added.

Most likely, Tel Aviv would want to push the two to the brink of war by allowing its fighter jets to fly closely to Iranian jets and passenger planes - just as the US recently has done, in hopes that such a move would cause an accident that could lead to a plane crash or a fierce battle between the two sides' air forces, according to Korybko.

Ansarullah, Iran on same axis against US, Israeli regime

Mohamed al-Bukhaiti, a member of Yemen's Supreme Political Council, said Ansarullah and Iran are on a single axis in an unlimited war against the United States and the Israeli regime in the region.

Remarks of al-Bukhaiti, who is a senior official with Yemen's Houthi Ansarullah movement, came in reaction to the US' recent harassment of Iran's Mahan airliner in Syria.

"Ansarullah's retaliatory response to the harassment of the American fighter jets for Iranian civilian aircraft will be determined in proper time, but Ansarullah's response will not replace that of Iran's," he told Sputnik Radio network.

He added that "Resistance is a single axis against American hegemony."

"Ansarullah and Iran are on a single axis in an unlimited war against the United States and Israeli regime in the region," Raialyoum quoted him as saying.

Two US warplanes put the lives of tens of Iranian and Lebanese civilians in danger after conducting dangerous maneuvering near Beirut-bound Mahan Air's Flight 1152 on Syria's air last Thursday night.

Iran immediately reacted to the incident, saying it will give a firm response in proper time.

"The Islamic Republic of Iran leaves no hostile action against the Iranian nation unanswered and will give a firm and appropriate response to any unwise measure when the time is ripe," Seyyed Abbas Mousavi said on Friday, hours after two US warplanes conducted dangerous maneuvering near Mahan Air's Flight 1152. Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif also condemned the 'lawlessness' of the United States which 'endangered' lives of civilians on board the Iranian airliner.

Defense Ministry unveils domestic ATC tower

Iran's Defense Ministry has unveiled a homegrown advanced air traffic control tower.

In a ceremony in Tehran on Monday, Defense Minister Brigadier General Amir Hatami unveiled the air control tower, which has been developed and manufactured by SAIran, an electronics company run by the Iranian defense ministry.

According to General Hatami, the new achievement is equipped with domestically-built tools, including air control radio, telephone and radio recording systems, radio switching systems, and network synchronization systems.

All the equipment comply with the world's latest developments and standards, he added.

The minister noted that each control tower will help save at least 2 million euros by preventing the imports of the equipment.

General Hatami said the mobile air control tower will help the country show a quicker response to different emergencies, including natural disasters such as earthquakes and floods, across the country.

Nancy Pelosi Nicknames Trump 'Mr. Make Matters Worse'

House Speaker Nancy Pelosi on Sunday slammed US President Donald Trump's handling of the coronavirus pandemic and gave him the nickname "Mr. Make Matters Worse."

"This president, I have a new name for him: Mr. Make Matters Worse. He has made matters worse from the start. Delay, denial, it's a hoax, or going magically - it's a miracle, and all the rest," the California Democrat said on CBS News program "Face the Nation."

Pelosi jabbed at Trump as Senate Republicans prepare to introduce coronavirus legislation on Monday after talks with the White House. House Democrats passed a rival \$3 trillion bill in May.

The House speaker objected to a Republican liability waiver for employers and said she wants more money for school preparedness. Many other issues divide the parties, including the size of unemployment benefits and whether to bail out state governments, the New York Post reported.

Trump and Pelosi have had an acrimonious relationship, especially after her leadership in impeaching him in December for pushing Ukraine to investigate Democrats.

In May, the clash got ugly when Pelosi said on CNN that Trump should not be taking the drug hydroxychloroquine to protect against COVID-19 because he is "morbidly obese." Trump, in turn, told reporters at the Capitol that Pelosi is a "sick woman" with "mental problems."

The next day, Pelosi claimed she's spoken to doctors about Trump's mental state and decided he's "a confabulator - someone who just really doesn't even know what the truth is." "It's like a child who comes in with mud on their pants or



something - that's the way it is, they're outside playing. He comes in with doggy doo on his shoes and everybody who works with him has that on their shoes, too," she said.

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US harassment of Iranian airliner unforgivable: Raesi

Emphasizing that the recent US harassment of a passenger plane is a gross violation of international law, Iran's Judiciary Chief Seyyed Ebrahim Raesi called the US action unforgivable. "The solution to end the US wickedness in the region is to expel them from the region," said Raesi on Saturday referring to the recent provocation by US warplanes against an Iranian airliner. "The US harassment of a passenger plane is a gross violation of international law," he added, stressing, "The US action is unforgivable." "Iran's Attorney General and the deputy of international affairs of Judiciary will diligently follow up on the complaints of the passengers of this plane," Raesi added. 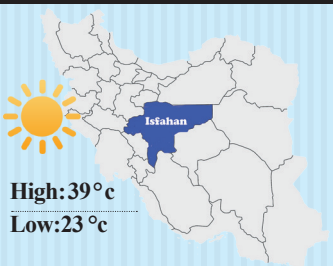

Switzerland says SHTA's 1st transaction completed

Switzerland announced on Monday that its first deal with Iran through Swiss Humanitarian Trade Arrangement (SHTA) has been completed. As the New York Times reported, a Swiss pharmaceutical company has completed the first transaction under a new humanitarian trade channel with Iran. "We would like to emphasize that the operationalization of the SHTA is progressing and that a number of companies have already been approved, more companies will follow. Further transactions should be carried out shortly," the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) said. SECO did not identify the Swiss drugmaker or give a value for the shipment, which it said involved a cancer drug used to treat iron overload caused by repeated blood transfusions.

China takes over U.S. consulate premises in Chengdu as ties worsen

China said it had taken over the premises of the U.S. consulate in the southwestern city of Chengdu on Monday after ordering the facility be shut in retaliation for being ousted from the Chinese consulate in Houston, Texas.

Police in Chengdu restricted access to the area around the consulate on Monday morning, and four officials in personal protective gear were seen walking towards the consulate at about 10:24 a.m. local time (0224 GMT).

China's Ministry of Foreign Affairs said the consulate was closed as of 10 a.m. It said later that authorities entered the building and took over the premises.

China ordered the closure of the facility on Friday after Washington last week gave China 72 hours to vacate its consulate in Houston, in a dramatic escalation of tensions between the world's two largest economies.

The United States confirmed the closure of the consulate in a farewell video shared from the U.S. embassy in China's Twitter account.

"The U.S. consulate in Chengdu has been proudly promoting the mutual understanding between Americans and the people in Sichuan, Chongqing, Guizhou, Yunnan and Tibet since 1985. We will forever miss you," it said.

State broadcaster CCTV shared a video on its Twitter-like Weibo account, taken by a reporter, of the American flag in front of the consulate in Chengdu being lowered at 6:18 a.m. on Monday.

On Sunday night, a crane was seen entering the consulate compound and hoisting at least one container onto a large truck.

On Saturday evening, a worker was seen using tools including a hammer and chisel to remove fittings around a plaque outside the main entrance. U.S.-China relations have plunged to their worst in decades over a range of disputes, from trade and technology to the COVID-19 pandemic, China's territorial claims in the South China Sea and its clampdown on Hong Kong.

Iran will pursue peaceful nuclear program with IAEA

Deputy Foreign Minister for Political Affairs Abbas Araghchi said on Sunday that Iran will continue peaceful nuclear activities with the International Atomic Energy Agency according to the regulations agreed with the IAEA.

In an article published in a special issue of Polish Magazine 'Politika Polska' on the occasion of the fifth anniversary of JCPOA, he added that whenever Iran's interests are served under the deal, the country is ready to return to its commitments.

Iran has always been seeking to exploit nuclear knowledge to meet its development needs, both in the years before the victory of the 1979

Islamic Revolution and in the years after, he said.

Criticizing deal-bashing policies of the western states, Araghchi said that it seems that their general perception was that with the departure of technical experts and investments made, Iran's nuclear activities in line with development of the country would stop.

Araghchi also slammed monopolistic policies of the owners of nuclear technologies, saying that they have adopted contractionary policy against any request.

Referring to Iran's continuous adherence to cooperation with IAEA, he said that despite political propaganda by elements affiliated to the Western and Israeli security services, Iran has never cut off cooperation and dialogue with the

International Atomic Energy Agency. As a responsible and accountable country to the international community, Iran responded to all ambiguities and misinformation about its peaceful nuclear activities and made it fully transparent to the competent international body, the International Atomic Energy Agency, the senior diplomat said.

Finally, the massive news propaganda against Iran's peaceful nuclear program was thwarted by providing information, conducting numerous inspections, installing cameras, and presence of IAEA inspectors at all nuclear sites and related activities, he said.

The use of peaceful energy is an inalienable right of the Iranian people, and Iran will not surrender this right to the US bullying, he said.

Iran always backs countries' territorial integrity

Iranian President's Chief of Staff Mahmoud Vaezi said Tehran has always backed countries' territorial integrity and sovereignty, stressing that solving disputes peacefully will help the maintain regional stability.

In a Sunday telephone conversation with Azeri President's Foreign Policy Advisor Hikmat Hajiyev, Vaezi said supporting the territorial integrity and sovereignty of countries is the official policy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in issues and disputes, adding that tensions in the region have not been and are not in the interest of any country.

He stressed that Iran seeks stability, development and progress of all countries, especially the Republic of Azerbaijan, expressing hope that the existing conflicts in the region will be resolved through dialogue and peaceful solutions.

They talked about the issue of expanding cooperation to reduce the impacts of the coronavirus outbreak on the two countries' economies, according to Uzbekistan National News Agency (UzA)
