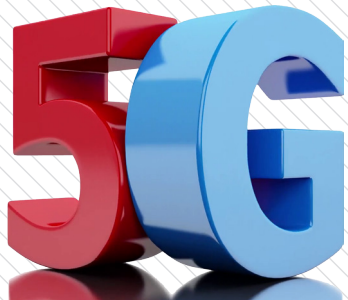

Daily gas production in SP phases 24, 22 at 40 mcm: official

The Director of Refinery No. 12 of South Pars Gas Field (SPGF) put the daily gas production in Phases 22 and 24 of the Field at 40 million cubic meter (mcm). Speaking in an interview with IRNA on Sat., Mehdi Gerami Shirazi added, "Since SP phases 22 and 24 have newly been launched, their daily gas production capacity has reached 40 million cubic meters." Presently, Refinery No. 12 of South Pars delivers about 46 million cubic meters gas per day while more than 40 million cubic meters of gas is produced and exported, he stated. Elsewhere in his remarks, he pointed to the commissioning of propane and butane production units and added, "In Refinery No. 12, 1,080 and 600 tons of propane and butane is produced per day respectively."

Production of other refinery products is underway according to the scheduled program, Gerami maintained. Presently, about 70 percent of gas consumed in the country is provided from South Pars Joint Gas Field, he said, adding, "Inauguration of new phases in the government dubbed 'Hope and Prudence' in tandem with construction of onshore facilities has increased gas supply significantly."

Iran cosmetic export to 21 countries hit 10\$mn in 5 month

The Spokesman of the Iranian Customs Administration said that in the first 5 months of the current year ending on Sep. 21, Iran has exported 13,765 tons of beauty and health products worth more than \$10 million to 21 countries.

In the first five months of the current Iranian year (March 20-September 21), Iran has exported 13,765 tons of beauty and health products worth \$10,598, 620 million to 21 countries, Seyed Ruhollah Latifi said. According to Latifi, Iranian beauty products including shampoos, health products, and cosmetics for face, skin, fingernails, and toenails, compressed powders for cosmetic purposes, beauty and hygiene products for skincare and all kinds of sunscreens, hair fixatives as well as cleansing products such as toothpaste, types of soap have exported to countries such as Afghanistan, England, Germany, Canada, Austria, Hong Kong, Kuwait, Oman, UAE, Russia, Iraq, Bahrain, Turkey, Azerbaijan, Armenia, as Kazakhstan during the mentioned period.

According to the Spokesman of the Iranian Customs Administration, the three main destinations for the export of Iranian health and beauty products are Afghanistan, Iraq, and Azerbaijan, respectively.

China ready to cooperate with Iranian publishers

China is ready to develop cooperation with Iran in the publishing industry, a Chinese author announced. Zhou Hongbo, the editor-in-chief of Chinese Publishing House Commercial Press, told IRNA that relations between Iran and China are historical and long-lasting. He said that Chinese people are interested in Iran's rich civilization and culture. Referring to the House's cooperation with Iran, the author said it is publishing a book on Persian literature. Cooperation with Iran will develop after the pandemic period is over, Hongbo noted. Chinese Publishing House Commercial Press will work on teaching Chinese and Persian languages in the near future, he added.

COVID19-threatens 120m tourism-related jobs: UN Chief

United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres in his message on World Tourism Day, 27 September 2020, said some 120 million tourism-related jobs are at risk due to COVID19.



According to the United Nations Information Center (UNIC) in Tehran, in the 40 years since the very first World Tourism Day, much has changed, demand for travel has soared, the world has opened up, allowing more people than ever to explore the globe and its different cultures. The full text of his message reads: Today, tourism is firmly established in the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development as an engine for advancing prosperity, protecting our planet and laying the foundations for peace and understanding among peoples. Many millions of people around the world rely on tourism for income, especially women and young people. People who might otherwise have been left behind have found decent work and the chance of a better

life thanks to tourism's unique potential. Tourism has suffered enormously during the COVID-19 pandemic. Some 120 million jobs are at risk. The impacts could lead to the loss of between 1.5 and 2.8 percent of the global GDP. This will particularly affect the most vulnerable countries, including Small Island Developing States, the Least Developed Countries and many African nations, where tourism can represent between 30 and 80 percent of exports. As we look to recover from this profound crisis, the safe restart of tourism is essential, not least for rural development - the focus of this year's

World Tourism Day. We have an unprecedented opportunity to transform the relationship of the tourism sector with people, nature, the climate and the economy. We must ensure a fair distribution of its benefits and advance the transition to a carbon-neutral and resilient tourism economy. As well as providing opportunities for people, tourism can play an important role in preserving our unique and shared cultures and protecting the biodiversity and the ecosystems that sustain us. In this most challenging year, let us focus on tourism's importance

for people living in rural areas, so we can deliver on the promise of the Sustainable Development Goals to leave nobody behind. As of 1980, World Tourism Day is celebrated annually across the world on September 27. It was on this day in 1970 when the Statutes of the UNWTO were adopted as a milestone of global tourism. UNWTO celebrated the first World Tourism Day as an international observance on September 27, 1980. The purpose of this day is to raise awareness on the importance of tourism in affecting the social, cultural, political, and economic values of the international community.

38% Decrease in HI Tehran Home Construction Permits

The first half of the current Iranian year (March 20-Sept. 21) registered a 38% decline in the number of permits issued to home builders, says the head of Construction Engineering Organization of Tehran Province. Saeed Saeedian added that this has heightened concerns about the loss of jobs in engineering and construction, ILNA reported. "As the largest organization affiliated to the private sector, the Construction Engineering Organization of Tehran Province has 120,000 members, of whom 70,000 are licensed builders," he said. Noting that the outbreak of coronavirus accelerated the shift to online services, Saeedian said his organization now offers 90% of its services electronically.

Free Trade, Special Economic Zones Account for 40% of Iranian Exports

Exports through Iran's free trade and special economic zones have reached \$169 billion during the seven years since President Hassan Rouhani first took office in August 2013. Exports from Iran's free trade and special economic zones account for 40% of the country's total exports during the seven years since President Hassan Rouhani first took office in August 2013. According to Secretary of the High Council of Free Trade Zones and Special Economic Areas Morteza Bank, exports through FTZs and SEZs reached \$169 billion during the period under review. "Overall imports from these trade zones have hit \$45 billion over the seven-year period," he was quoted as saying by IRNA. FTZs were first authorized in 1993 on Kish Island, Qeshm Island and Chabahar Port. Later, Aras, Arvand, Maku and Anzali were added to the list.

Official: €500m investment to be made in Chabahar

Chabahar potentials have attracted many investors and a company has requested to make €550m investment in Chabahar, deputy governor of Sistan and Baluchestan for economic affairs said on Sunday.

Mandana Zangeneh said that thanks to its water capacities, access to ocean, having common border with Pakistan and enjoying economic zone's incentives, Chabahar has become one of the most strategic areas in Iran for businessmen and investors.

She added that an investment company has made proposal to set up refinery and produce fuel for heavy vessels so that the project is predicted to need 400-500 million Euros.

The first phase of the project will start with €150m credit, she noted.

She pointed to the project of building a hotel with 300 apartments in south of the province, saying it will be carried out in three phases.

Chabahar, as Iran's only ocean port, plays an important role in developing trade, exports, and imports and in fishing as well.

Supreme Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei's special attention and the efforts made by President Hassan Rouhani's government have accelerated development of Makran Coasts, especially Chabahar Port, in a way that five big ships carrying basic goods, including wheat, barley, soybean, and corn berthed in one week.

Hajizadeh: Iran among top 5 countries in drone, missile tech

The Commander of IRGC Aerospace Force noted that the country's defense sector enjoys high-tech equipment made by Iranian experts.

Iran's aerospace section and its achievements are standing at the world's top-level, Brigadier General Amir Ali Hajizadeh said on Sunday in the inauguration ceremony of an exhibition which showcases the achievements of the force.

"When we talk about missile, drone, and radar development, these are cutting edge technologies and we are among the top five countries in these fields," he added.

He noted that the defense achievements of the country have been the result of experiences during Sacred Defense. "We learned from Imam Khomeini to stand on our own feet. Of course, we faced challenges in the path. At the time of the Soviet Union collapse, millions of dollars' worth missiles and launchers were being easily offered to us but the Leader of the Islamic Revolution opposed. If those purchases had been made, we would have not gained these achievements and this progress is the result of the wisdom of the Leader."

He noted that the exhibition aims to inject self-confidence in the younger generation while also transferring the key of these technologies to others.

The Brigadier General also said that country's problems can be solved with self-confidence. The exhibition has been opened on the occasion of the Sacred Defense Week which marks the start of imposed Saddam Hussein's war on Iran in 1980.

The Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI) said the Islamic Republic has adopted a "transparent approach" in its cooperation with the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA).

This issue proves the rightfulness of using this energy for the Iranian people," it added in a follow-up tweet. "The @aeoinews with an outlook based on peaceful use of the nuclear technology has promoted its scientific programs in the areas of health, agriculture, food, radiopharmaceuticals, stable isotopes and etc. in a precise and determined manner and #sanctions imposed on #Iranian_nuclear_scientists will not interrupt Iran's nuclear program strategic principle," it

said in another tweet. The AEOI further quoted Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyed Ali Khamenei as saying, "The Islamic Republic of Iran has never sought nuclear weapons and will not surrender the right of its people to peaceful use of nuclear energy." On Monday, the US slapped new restrictive measures on Iran over its nuclear program, claiming it was enforcing a UN arms embargo.



Pres. Rouhani: Iran considers US presence detrimental to regional security

Iran's President said that the Iranian nation and government consider Iraq as their friend and have been with the Iraqi government and people at various times to help them, adding, "We have always supported the Iraqi people and the legitimate government at various times, and the best example is helping the Iraqi people and government during the terrorist attacks of ISIL in the country".



Speaking in a meeting with Iraqi Foreign Minister Fuad Hussein, Dr. Hassan Rouhani said that today, we consider the unity among Shiites

and interaction among different groups, including Shiites, Sunnis and Kurds in the country an important principle, adding, "We stand with the government and people of Iraq to contribute to the unity and cohesion of Iraq". We have always made our views clear and unequivocal in our political positions, he said, adding, "We consider the presence of American armed forces in the region, whether in Iraq, Afghanistan or the Persian Gulf's southern countries, detrimental to regional security and stability".

Emphasizing that trying to get the United States out of the region is not only our responsibility, but that of any country in which the Americans are present, Dr. Rouhani said, "We consider what the Iraqi parliament and its representatives have approved in this regard a positive step, which is

respected by the Iraqi people, and supported by us". We have never sought to interfere in the internal affairs of Iraq and the relations among Iraqi groups, he said, adding, "We have always believed that Iraqi groups should have good relations for the preservation and development of their country". Emphasizing the development and deepening of relations between the two countries in various political, cultural and especially economic fields, Dr. Rouhani stressed the need to accelerate the implementation and operation of the agreements between the two countries, which were emphasized during the visit of Iranian and Iraqi officials.

"As officials of the two countries, we have a duty to strengthen the foundations for the development and deepening of relations in the

future," the president said. Stating that we are still committed to the development and deepening of political, economic and cultural cooperation between the two nations, Dr. Rouhani expressed hope that with the visit of the Iraqi Foreign Minister to Tehran will bring about a good momentum in the implementation of agreements between the two countries.

In a meeting with Iraq's Foreign Minister Fuad Hussein, held in Tehran on Sunday, Shamkhani said Iran expects the Baghdad government to seriously pursue the cowardly move through international organizations.

Denouncing the American assassination of Lt. General Soleimani and Iraqi commander Abu Mahdi al-Muhandis as a brazen example of state-sponsored terrorism, Shamkhani said the least punishment for such a grave crime is that those behind the plot must immediately get out of the region,

specifically out of Iraq.

For his part, Hussein praised Iran for supporting the Iraqi government and nation in the fight against Takfiri terrorism, stressing that no foreign party can undermine the close relations between the two neighbors.

In July, Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyed Ali Khamenei warned the United States that Iran will definitely reciprocate the assassination of Lt. General Soleimani.

In a meeting with Iraqi Prime Minister Mustafa al-Kadhimi in Tehran, Ayatollah Khamenei underlined that the Islamic Republic of Iran will never forget the American assassination of the top commander in Iraq and "it will definitely deal the reciprocal blow to Americans."

On January 3, a US drone strike near Baghdad International Airport assassinated General Soleimani, former commander of the Quds Force of Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps. The attack — that also killed Abu Mahdi al-Muhandis, the second-in-command of Iraq's Popular

IRGC Unveils New Naval Ballistic Missile

The Islamic Revolution Guards Corps unveiled a new naval ballistic missile with a range of over 700 kilometers.

The IRGC's new ballistic missile, "Zolfaqar Basir", has been put on display in a permanent exhibition of the achievements of the IRGC Aerospace Force that was inaugurated on Sunday morning.

Known as the latest version of a new generation of 'Persian Gulf' missiles, Zolfaqar Basir has a range of above 700 kilometers and its warhead is equipped with an optical seeker.

The range of the IRGC's previous naval missiles, Persian Gulf and Hormuz, was around 300 and 250 km respectively.

The ground-to-ground version of Zolfaqar missile has a range of about 750 kilometers. It was used in an operation against Daesh terrorists in Syria in October 2018 and in a missile attack on the US airbase of Ain al-Assad in Iraq in January 2020.

Iranian officials have repeatedly underscored that the country will not hesitate to strengthen its military capabilities, including its missile power, which are entirely meant for defense, and that Iran's defense capabilities will be never subject to negotiations.

Back in February 2018, Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyed Ali Khamenei called for efforts to maintain and boost Iran's defense capabilities, hitting back at the enemies for disputing the country's missile program.

"Without a moment of hesitation, the country must move to acquire whatever is necessary for defense, even if the whole world is opposed to it," Ayatollah Khamenei said at the time.

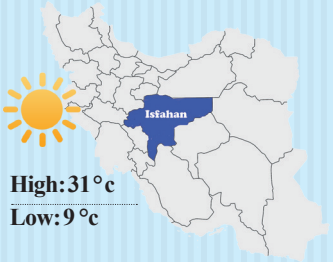

All Flights to Iraq Suspended Until Arbaeen

All domestic airlines have suspended flights to Iraq until Arbaeen that falls on Oct. 8 this year. According to Maqsood Asadi-Samani, secretary of the Association of Iranian Airlines, only an Iraqi airline is operating flights to the neighboring country to transport those holding Iraq residency, Fars News Agency reported. "Iraq has banned the entry of foreign pilgrims for Arbaeen this year due to the Covid-19 outbreak," he said. Top General: UAE to Be Treated as Enemy If Israel Hurts Iran's Security

Iran's highest-ranking military commander warned the United Arab Emirates that it will be held accountable for any harm to the Islamic Republic's security caused by the Zionist regime as the Arab country has normalized ties with Israel.

Now the US has hit the rock bottom in dealing with the JCPOA, an important accord whose negotiations took more than a decade.

In a televised interview on Saturday night, Chief of Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces Major General Mohammad Hossein Baqeri decried the UAE's move to normalize relations with Israel although the Emiratis had sent Iran messages over the past two years demanding that Tehran not treat them the same as Saudi Arabia. Things changed when the UAE announced the normalization of relations with Israel, which means allowing the establishment of military bases and bases for intelligence and cyber operations, the commander noted. "If the Zionists establish a foothold in the region and our defense and security are harmed, then we will regard them (UAE) as the one that has provided the



enemy with bases, and will treat them as an enemy," Major General Baqeri warned. The commander further derided the Zionist regime's idea of ruling over regions from the Nile to the Euphrates, saying Israel is struggling to survive and would fall apart if the US halts its economic support for a moment. The United Arab Emirates and Israel announced in August they have reached a deal that will lead to a full normalization of diplomatic relations. The move has drawn strong criticism from many Islamic countries and regional organizations.

Leaders to UN: If Virus Doesn't Kill Us, Climate Change Will

In a year of cataclysm, some world leaders at this week's annual United Nations meeting are taking the long view, warning: If COVID19- doesn't kill us, climate change will.

referring to the sparkling skies that followed lockdowns to slow the spread of the virus around the world. Pollution has crept back up as restrictions ease.

World powers cannot shirk their financial commitments to fighting climate change during the pandemic, Remengesau said, even as economies are battered.

But few pledges have emerged at the UN gathering, aside from China's announcement that it aims to have carbon dioxide emissions peak before 2030 and achieve carbon neutrality by 2060.

The pandemic has muted the UN meeting, with world leaders speaking not from the podium in New York but via video from home. That has sapped the urgency of diplomacy and left nations wondering just how many people are listening. Amid concerns that the world is distracted, it was perhaps no surprise that the student-led movement Fridays for Future returned to the streets this week for the first major demonstrations for climate action in months. Still, island nations have seized on the unusual circumstances to show off what's at stake.

The prime minister of Tuvalu, Kausea Natano, delivered his UN speech with a vista of turquoise waters and swaying fronds behind him that instantly fired the imaginations of house-bound viewers.

But the prime minister quickly shattered any dreams. While Tuvalu is free of the coronavirus, the pandemic struck as the island nation was recovering from a pair of tropical cyclones — storms that scientists say are likely to become wetter as the planet warms.

Tuvalu's highest point is just a few meters (yards) above sea level. The pandemic's effect on the movement of goods exposed food insecurity as local agriculture becomes more difficult with rising sea levels, Natano said.

"While COVID-19 is our immediate crisis, climate change remains the single greatest threat to the livelihoods, security and well-being of the Pacific and its peoples in the long run," the prime minister said.

With Siberia seeing its warmest temperature on record this year and enormous chunks of ice caps in Greenland and Canada sliding into the sea, countries are acutely aware there's no vaccine for global warming.

"We are already seeing a version of environmental Armageddon," Fiji's Prime Minister Frank Bainimarama said, citing wildfires in the western US and noting that the Greenland ice chunk was larger than a number of island nations, AP reported.

This was meant to be the year "we took back our planet," he said. Instead, the coronavirus has diverted resources and attention from what could have been the marquee issue at this UN gathering. Meanwhile, the UN global climate summit has been postponed to late 2021.

That hasn't stopped countries, from slowly sinking island nations to parched African ones, from speaking out.

"In another 75 years, many ... Members may no longer hold seats at the United Nations if the world continues on its present course," the Alliance of Small Island States and the Least Developed Countries Groups said.

The main goal of the 2015 Paris climate accord is to limit the rise in global temperatures to 2 degrees Celsius (3.6 degrees Fahrenheit) above pre-industrial times, but scientists say the world is on track to soar past that. A new study found that if the world warms another 0.9 degrees Celsius (1.6 degrees Fahrenheit), the West Antarctic ice sheet will reach a point of irreversible melting. It has enough water to raise global sea levels by 5 meters (16 feet).

The Pacific island nation of Palau hasn't had a single COVID-19 infection, but President Tommy E. Remengesau Jr. warns it's the rising seas that will bring the country down.

"The momentary drop in (carbon) emissions this year cannot be allowed to generate any complacency about global progress," he said,
